PREFACE

The bibliography presented here is an updated version of an earlier publication prepared by the Krannert Library staff in 1971. Such a compilation has proven to be an excellent source of information on graduate student research, and this edition brings together in one chronological sequence all doctoral dissertations successfully submitted by students in the Agricultural Economics Department of Purdue University from 1937 to December, 1977.

It includes, besides the chronological file and the author listing, a detailed subject index. It has been evident that a subject approach to these dissertations is useful both for faculty and students and all others interested in this area of research.

Information on each dissertation is arranged as follows: Year of completion, author, full title, the number of pages, and the name of the major professor. The entries, arranged chronologically, are consecutively numbered and these numbers are used for identification in the author and subject indexes.

Conformance with the <u>Agricultural/Biological Vocabulary</u> of the National Agricultural Library was maintained, whenever possible, in the selection of the subject terms. They were adjusted where necessary to reflect the more specific terminology of agricultural economics.

All of the dissertations listed are available for use in the Krannert Library. Some can be borrowed through interlibrary loan or ordered directly from Xerox University Microfilms. In addition, abstracts of the dissertations are kept in the library for consultation.

The compiler gratefully acknowledges assistance received from Judith Pask for her editorial work on the manuscript and from Jill Tatem for expertly preparing the typed copy.

It is hoped that this cumulative catalog will be of value to all who are interested in the research undertaken by students of the Department of Agricultural Economics during the past forty years.
