The honour of Fellow, to be given annually, to an Indian scholar who has made outstanding contribution in the field of agriculture and rural development.

The award will consist of a citation and the designation of Indian Society of Agricultural Economics Fellow. The fellow selection committee will select the Fellow. The maximum number of new fellows in any year would be not more than three members selected from the nominations received by the Fellow Selection Committee. The Fellows Recognition Ceremony will be held as part of the Society's Annual Conferences.

Any ISAE Past Conference President may nominate any living member who has been a member of the Society for minimum 10 years and who has been actively involved with the Society and the age limit is 50 years and above. The Indian Society of Agricultural Economics Fellow Selection Committee is inviting nominations for the 2011 ISAE Fellow Awards. The deadline for submission of nominations and the supporting documentation is June 30, 2011. Nominations received beyond this date will not be entertained. Besides any person who has been subject to official inquiry for any irregularities is not eligible for the Award.

Nominations of President(s) and Conference President(s) (ex- and current) should not be made as they are deemed to be Honorary Fellows.
