## INTRODUCTION

A research program for 5 years was elaborated in 1970 by the Research Institute for Agricultural Economics. One project within the entire mid-term program – developed at the Department for Economic Policy – has been:

„The development of the system of economic regulators in food economy, the scientific foundation of economic political decisions by budgetary relations, prices, incomes as well as by the survey of the international and regional context”

Results of research concerning prices, incomes and budgetary relations achieved in course of one and a half year are reported in this booklet in the form of digests made of papers already published.

In consequence of the nature of research activities, the subjects presented imply mainly the elucidation, analysis and evaluation of the situation and consequently they offer a basis for further research. Thus they cannot be considered as the final products of a longer research period but only as partial results.
