1. Production

The 1991 Volume of the *Review* was the third produced under the name of the The Australian Agricultural Economics Society, Inc. Previous to 1989 the *Review* was published by NSW Agriculture. The April, August and December issues of the 1991 Volume were distributed to all Society members and to all library subscribers to the *Review*.

These three issues of the *Review* also saw the continuation of desktop publishing and copying procedures in place of the traditional typesetting and printing methods of producing the journal. Substantial savings have continued to be made through the use of these technologies. Greater coordination has been achieved with the Editors of the *AJAE* and editorial styles are now closely matched.
