Journal of Agricultural and Applied Economics Guidelines for Submission of Manuscripts

The Journal of Agricultural and Applied Economics welcomes manuscripts dealing with any topic related to agricultural and applied economics, including manuscripts dealing with economic development and resource economics. Articles, comments and replies are reviewed on a continuous basis. Authors of articles should adhere to the following guidelines. There are no specific page limits, but manuscripts longer than 30 double-spaced pages probably need further editing.

Cover Letter: Indicate why you believe the material will be of interest to the readers of the *Journal* and whether the material has been submitted or published elsewhere. Articles that are currently under review or have been published by another scholarly journal will be returned. The letter should also indicate that the article does not infringe on any known copyright.

Cover Page: The *Journal* uses a system of blind reviews. Thus, all copies of the submitted manuscript should have a removable cover page that indicates the authors names and institutional affiliations. The first page of the manuscript must not contain the author'(s) name(s).

Format: Manuscripts submitted for review should be typed double spaced on 8 1/2" by 11" paper using a 10 point font with a 1.25 inch margin. Indent each paragraph 1/2 inch.

Footnotes and References: See examples in this issue of the *Journal* for specific guidelines for references and footnotes.

Tables: If possible, tables should fit vertically on the page. Follow the table design layout used in this issue of the *Journal*. Do not use vertical lines in tables.

Charts and Figures: Please supply charts and figures in a form suitable for camera-ready duplication.

Mathematical Style: This issue of the *Journal* illustrates some examples of appropriate mathematical style. Particularly note the use of italics in mathematical equations.

Page Charge: Authors of accepted manuscripts or their designated host institutions are charged \$65.00 per page. Page charges are not waived for any reason.

Copyright: The Journal of Agricultural and Applied Economics is copyrighted. Authors are required to sign a release form which will prohibit publication of material contained in the article elsewhere unless specific permission is granted by the Journal. Authors should not submit material that has been or is being published in other copyrighted media. Submitted articles are often based on work conducted by graduate students or in cooperation with other faculty. Authors frequently use models constructed by other faculty or students as the basis for conducting additional applied economic research. Students or faculty whose work formed a basis for the article should be listed as authors, or permission to report the research should be obtained from all individuals involved.

Printing Procedure: The Journal of Agricultural and Applied Economics is printed from a disk copy of each article supplied by the authors. This helps keep page charges low, reduces errors, and reduces publication costs for the Southern Association. If response from the external review is favorable, you will receive explicit instructions for the final preparation of the manuscript for publication. The editors will request a disk copy of the manuscript when the manuscript has been accepted, at the same time a request is made for a copyright release. Do NOT sent disk copies of manuscripts until requested by the editors. The Journal is set from Word Perfect 5.1. We can convert disks consisting of text generated from any of the IBM-compatible word processing packages. However, equations constructed using word processors other than Word Perfect must be reset, increasing production costs.

Copies: Send four copies. Critical reviews by colleagues prior to submission are encouraged.

Mailing: Send manuscripts to any of the three editors listed inside the front cover via first class mail.
