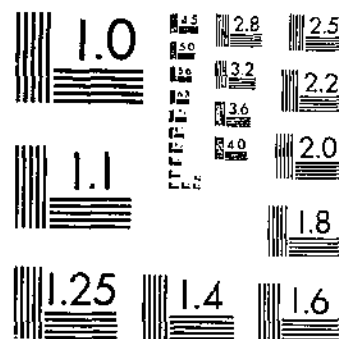
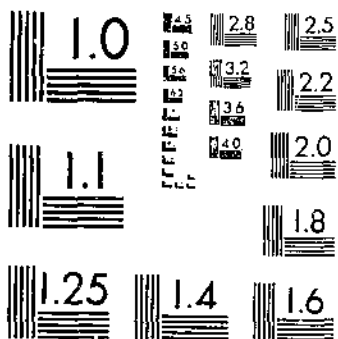

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**INTRODUCTION**

This, the fourth bulletin on cold-storage holdings, includes cold-storage warehouse space and cold-storage holdings of apples, dairy products, eggs, meats, lard, dressed poultry, and fish in the United States.

The biennial survey of refrigerated space of cold-storage warehouses and meat-packing establishments shown herein is as of October 1, 1927. The establishments included in this space survey are those artificially cooled to a temperature of 45° F., or below, in which food commodities are stored and held for 30 days or more and those in which meats and fish are frozen and cured. Since some commodities not reported as in cold storage are stored in space cooled to temperature varying from 45° F. to 60° F., all refrigerated space is shown in the tabulation in order to make a complete report on refrigerated-storage space.

Changes occur from year to year not only in the number of establishments but in the amount of space in the different temperature groups. New establishments are usually of considerable size; those that discontinue are often small. The amount of space at the

different temperatures varies according to the demand for storage space for the various commodities.

It will be noticed in the tables devoted to refrigerated space that, compared with those of the 1925 survey, there is a net increase of 40 concerns, with a total capacity of 41,178,823 cubic feet. In this bulletin, information on warehouse space is given in greater detail. In addition to the United States total and subtotals by States, the capacity of the cold-storage warehouses in a number of the most important cities has been shown. The increase in warehouse capacity has been chiefly in the Pacific coast section. This can be accounted for largely by the erection of cold-storage warehouses in the Northwest for apple storage. There has also been considerable conversion of common storage to refrigeration in that section. The total increase for Alaska, California, Oregon, and Washington is 42 concerns, with a total capacity of 29,431,259 cubic feet.

No commodities have been added to the report since the last bulletin,<sup>3</sup> so that the commodity tables herein are similar to previous ones published, except that they are brought up to December 1, 1927; the fish tables to December 15, 1927. The calendar year arrangement has been continued as in the previous bulletin.

The report on apples, dairy products, eggs, poultry and meats, and lard continues to be released about the twelfth of each month and that on fish, which is compiled as of the fifteenth of each month is released on the last day of the month.

The weekly report on creamery butter, American cheese, case eggs, and poultry, giving the holdings in 26 of the cities having the largest stocks of these commodities, and which covers about 75 per cent of the United States total, is now well established. With several years background, this and the daily report from 10 cities showing about 50 per cent of the total, a very close estimate of the total stocks can be made.

Cooperation by the concerns furnishing the basic information for these reports continues good, and the complete reports represent very close to 100 per cent of the cold-storage stocks of the country.

Because occasional discrepancies are found in the schedules, revised figures for the preceding month are published with the report for the current month, but the variations between the preliminary and revised figures are relatively insignificant as compared with the total. Any apparent discrepancies which are important are adjusted by telegram before the release of the report. Those of minor importance are corrected by correspondence.

Current monthly figures of cold-storage holdings of all commodities except fish are published in Crops and Markets; they are available in mimeograph summary form, immediately after the release has been made. Details as to the holdings of fish may be had, as soon as they are compiled, from the Bureau of Agricultural Economics, United States Department of Agriculture, or from the Bureau of Fisheries, United States Department of Commerce.

An early release of the report on certain varieties of fish is made in mimeograph form and later a full report is made in bulletin form by the Bureau of Fisheries.

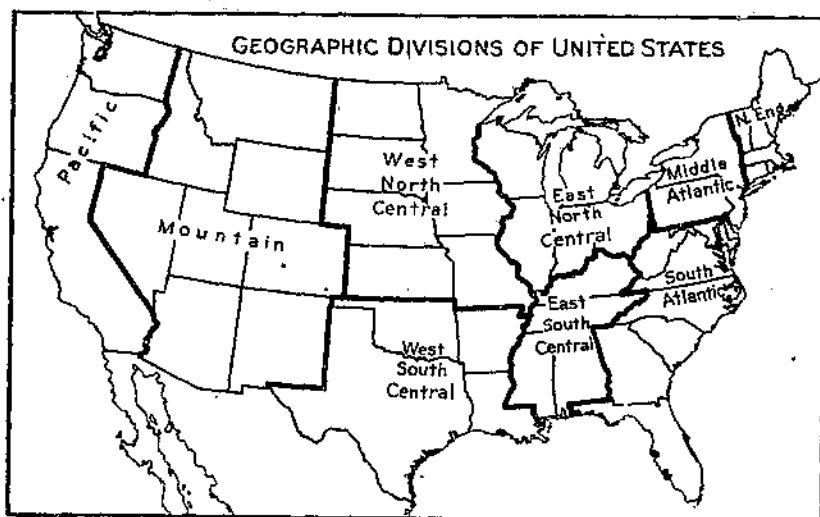


FIG. 1.—The census geographic divisions are used here

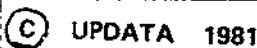
