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


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LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY ON FARMS AND RANCHES ON JANUARY 1,  
NUMBER, VALUE, AND CLASSES, 1945-50, BY STATES  
REVISED ESTIMATES

This publication presents a record of the revised estimates of the Crop Reporting Board of the Bureau of Agricultural Economics relating to livestock and poultry inventories as of January 1. It also contains revised estimates of livestock and poultry on farms by classes and their inventory values. These revised State and United States series result from the new 1950 bench marks obtained from an analysis of the 1950 Census enumeration and of other information such as State Farm Census data and records of numbers assessed for taxation. For livestock, consideration was also given to records relating to market receipts of livestock and livestock products, estimates of commercial and farm slaughter, current survey data, and information collected on disappearance during certain marketing periods. For poultry, consideration was given to reports and estimates of hatchery chick and poult production and to records relating to processing, shipping and inspections of poultry, as well as to the current general and special surveys conducted during the period.

NUMBER OF LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY ON FARMS, JANUARY 1

The annual estimates of numbers on farms January 1 are based primarily on survey returns from livestock and poultry producers, obtained mostly in cooperation with the Post Office Department through the rural mail carriers.

Data from the Bureau of the Census have been used as periodic bench marks for the January 1 estimates. These revised estimates for 1950 and the 1950 Census data are not in close agreement for all species. There are various reasons for these differences. One of the main reasons is that the 1950 Census of Agriculture took livestock and poultry inventories as of April 1, whereas the estimates relate to January 1. In order to adjust the 1950 Census to a January 1 base, a special survey was made in April to obtain livestock reporters' replies to questions on livestock designed and worded like those on the Census schedules. A special inquiry was used for turkeys. The results of these April surveys were matched against the reporters' replies to the regular livestock surveys sent out in December and January in order to obtain measures of change between January 1 and the date of the Census enumeration. Current monthly data collected on chicken numbers were used to measure the change between January 1 and the date of the Census enumeration. Other measures of change for the period based on records of marketings and allowances for deaths and slaughter were also used. These measurements assisted in the interpretation of the Census data and made it possible to use the Census data as bench marks for livestock and poultry numbers and classes as of January 1, even though the Census was taken in April.

VALUE PER HEAD AND TOTAL VALUE OF LIVESTOCK ON FARMS, JANUARY 1

The estimates of average value per head are based on reporters' estimates of average price per head in their localities, about January 1, each year. Crop reporters report values per head for different age, sex, and use classes of livestock and poultry. Values per head, by classes for each State, for a given species are weighted together by the estimates' numbers in each class. The weighted average so computed is the basis for the estimated value per head for the species.

In the case of estimates for regions and the United States, the total value is the sum of the State estimates; and value per head is derived by dividing the total number of head for the respective regions and for the United States.

The following tables show the revised estimates by States for the years 1945-50.
