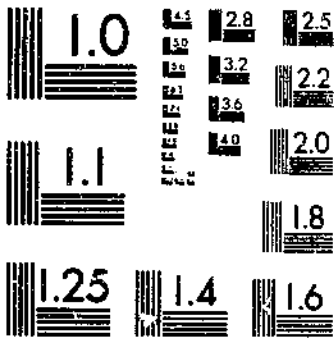

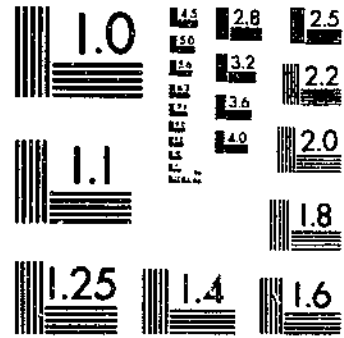

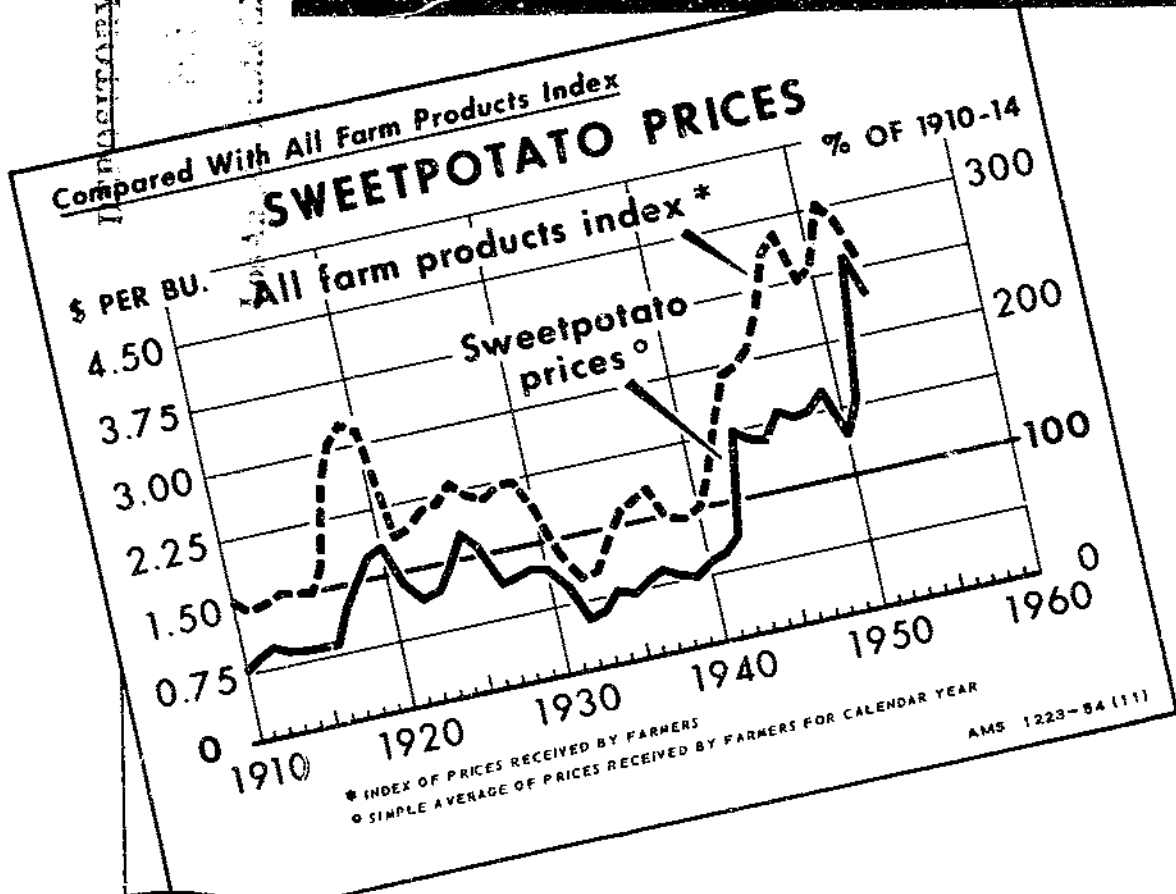

# SWEETPOTATO PRICES 1909-53

Prepared in the Agricultural Marketing Service 1/

This publication includes revised monthly prices received by farmers, together with season average prices, for all sweetpotatoes, by States and for the United States, covering the period 1909-53.

The United States monthly sweetpotato prices in this publication were obtained by weighting State monthly prices by estimated sales during the month. Prior to this publication the United States averages were obtained by weighting State monthly prices by crop-year production. The present series of United States prices is more representative of prices received by farmers for sweetpotatoes actually selling during a given month.

Monthly Prices -- Monthly prices in any State relate to the average price received by farmers for all grades, sizes, and varieties of sweetpotatoes selling on or about the middle of the month, priced at the point of first sale out of the farmers' hands. State estimates are made only for months in which sales exceed 0.5 percent of total sales for the crop year. The point of first sale may range all the way from sales at retail or sales on a graded, sacked, washed, and delivered basis as made by some farmers, to bulk sales, unwashed and ungraded, at the farm as made by other farmers. These are important factors in accounting for differences in prices among States.

Season Average Prices -- Season average prices for each State are based on monthly prices weighted by estimated sales for each month. Season average prices for the United States are based on State season average prices weighted by estimated sales for the crop year.
