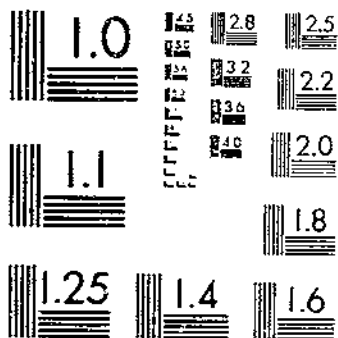

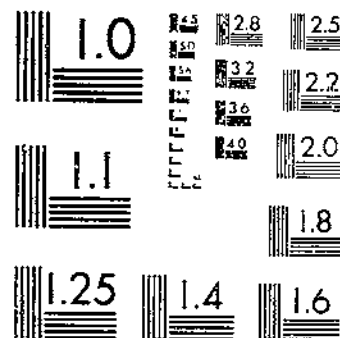

## CITRUS FRUITS

By States, 1949-50 -- 1955-56, Revised Estimates  
Production, Use, and Value

This report presents estimates by States of the production, farm disposition, value, and utilization of sales of citrus fruits for the crop seasons 1949-50 through 1955-56. These estimates by the Crop Reporting Board were revised on the basis of the 1954 Census of Agriculture and other pertinent data.

### Historical Series

For the benefit of individuals who are interested primarily in the historical series for the United States, Table 1 shows U. S. totals of production, farm disposition, value, and utilization of sales for the crop seasons 1934-35 through 1955-56.

Historical series for States, and the United States, are published in "Citrus Fruits, Production, Farm Disposition, Value, and Utilization of Sales, Crop Seasons 1909-10 -- 1943-44," issued October 1945, and in "Citrus Fruits, Production, Farm Disposition, Value, and Utilization of Sales, Crop Seasons 1944-45 -- 1949-50," issued October 1952.

### Crop Seasons

Orange and grapefruit trees generally bloom in late winter and early spring, and fruit is picked 8 to 18 months after blooming. Harvest extends from the fall of the year of bloom to the fall of the following year. Harvest of early and mid-season oranges, including Navels, starts in the early fall and continues until spring. Harvest of Valencia oranges in Florida, Texas, and Arizona extends from about the first of February to early summer. In northern California, Valencia harvest starts in March and is usually completed by early summer. In southern California, however, harvest generally starts about May 1 of the year after bloom and extends into December.

Grapefruit harvest, except for the California summer crop, begins in the fall in all States and ends by early summer of the next year. California summer grapefruit move to market from early summer through September of the year after bloom.

California lemons, which make up practically all of the Nation's lemon production, are harvested in all months of the year. The crop year is considered to be from November 1 to October 31.

Nearly all U. S. limes are grown in Florida and are picked mostly from April through December.

The values shown in this report relate to the crop seasons and should not be confused with estimates of calendar-year cash income.
