




TURKEYS

Farm Production, Disposition, Cash Receipts, and Gross Income, By States Revised Estimates 1955-59, and Numbers on Farms January 1, 1955-60

Revised estimates of farm production, disposition, and income from turkeys are presented in this report for 1955-59. These revisions resulted from a review and analysis of the 1950 Census of Agriculture enumeration of turkeys kept for breeders and turkeys raised during 1959 and of other available data relating to the production and disposition of turkeys. Revised estimates of breeder hens and all turkeys on January 1, 1956-60 also appear in this bulletin.

Turkeys Raised: These estimates are based primarily on hatchery records of placement of poult with allowance for death loss, adjusted where necessary in line with Census enumeration, market receipts, or assessor's enumerations.

January 1 Inventory Numbers: Inventory numbers of turkey breeder hens on farms January 1, 1960 were based primarily upon the Census enumeration and upon records of turkeys tested for pullorum disease. Annual changes in the estimates for intervening years are based on surveys of turkey growers and records of turkeys tested by official State agencies. Estimates of all turkeys on January 1 are made by adding estimates of market turkeys to the number of breeders on hand. Market turkeys are determined from grower surveys and from slaughter records.

Death Loss of Turkeys on Farms January 1: The estimates of the annual death loss of turkeys on farms are derived from losses as reported by turkey producers. These losses represent primarily the loss of breeder hens.

Turkeys Produced: This estimate represents the net annual farm production of turkeys, computed from the number raised during the year, less the death loss of turkeys that were on hand at the beginning of the year.

Farm Consumption: Consumption of turkeys in the households of farm producers is estimated from information from turkey growers who report the number of turkeys consumed in their households. The average consumption per turkey farm was multiplied by the estimated number of farms raising turkeys. Consumption in households of producers is less than 1 percent of production for the United States and will no longer be estimated as a separate item. Turkeys consumed in households of producers will be included in the estimate of turkeys sold.

Sales: The annual sales as shown in this publication are equal to the estimated production adjusted for inventory changes, less the consumption in farm households. Beginning with the year 1960, consumption in farm households will be included in the sales estimate.

Prices: The average value per head of turkeys on hand January 1, is based on the values reported by general crop correspondents. The average annual price per pound of turkey live weight is computed from monthly prices per pound received by farmers weighted by the estimated pounds sold each month.

Average Weight per Turkey Sold: The average live weight of turkeys sold is estimated from the average weights of turkey hens, toms, and fryer-roasters sold during the year as reported by turkey producers and from slaughter plant information.

Income: Cash receipts from turkeys is computed by multiplying the yearly total pounds of turkeys sold by the estimated annual price per pound received by farmers. Gross income is cash receipts plus the value of turkeys consumed in farm households, where produced. Turkey consumed at home is evaluated at the average annual price per pound received for turkeys sold.
