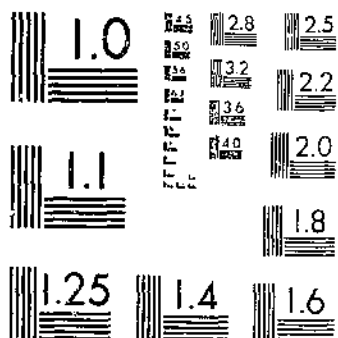

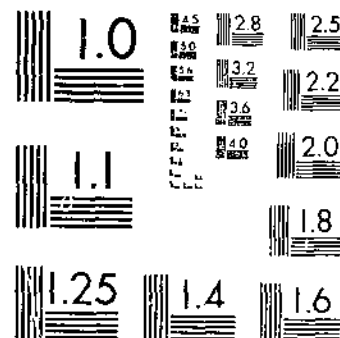

## PREFACE

An average price is computed by dividing the sum of the mid-points of price ranges reported during the period by the number of price ranges during the period.

A weighted average price is computed by dividing the total value of the sales during the period by the total number of units sold during the period.

An average price for a year is the mean of the twelve monthly averages.

A monthly average price is not computed when a price is not reported for five or more consecutive trading days.

A yearly average price is not computed when an average price is not reported for one or more months.
