


HIGHLIGHTS

Revision of earlier State-by-State estimates of farm real estate taxes paid shows little change from previous estimates in either tax per acre or tax per \$100 of full value.

For 1967--the most recent year for which estimates were revised--the estimate of average tax per acre was lowered from \$1.89 to \$1.84. Taxes per \$100 of full value showed a similar decrease from \$1.05 to \$1.02. The decline in farm acreage reduced the estimate of total taxes levied from \$1,940 million to \$1,858 million.

States with the largest changes in their yearly figures were those where the shift of land from farming to other uses has been the largest. This trend was especially noticeable among the States of the Northeastern region.

Revised Estimates of Taxes Levied on Farm Real Property, 1950-67

Each year the Department of Agriculture obtains sample data on taxes levied on farm real estate from more than 3,000 local tax officials. These sample data are used to determine the percentage change in farm real estate tax levies from the previous year. 1/

Farm real estate tax levies were first estimated by the Bureau of Agricultural Economics in 1922. State estimates of total taxes and tax per acre for 1913-14 and 1921-22 were prepared from data obtained through a survey of crop reporters. Later BAE studies extended the series to cover 1910-27. Unpublished summaries of responses to tax questions in the 1925 Census of Agriculture were used to verify and adjust these estimates.

A more detailed analysis of taxes levied on farmland was published in 1930 by the Bureau of the Census. These data provided the first benchmark estimates and served as the basis for revisions of the previously published series. Later, the series was extended back to 1890 through a special Federal project on the tax delinquency of rural real estate.

Since the thirties, there have been only minor changes in the methods used to estimate these taxes. 2/ However, because the estimating procedure relies heavily on an estimate of the number of acres of farmland in each acreage size grouping within each State, it is necessary to adjust these estimates to incorporate shifts in acreage which occur over time. These adjustments are made every 5 years after the publication of a new census of agriculture. In addition, a new benchmark is established every 10 years through a special census survey of taxes paid by farmers. All real estate tax estimates are then adjusted to the findings of this survey.

The most recent benchmark survey was made in 1960. The estimates in this report for 1950-59 are final and will not be revised. The estimates for 1960-67 reflect only the changes made to incorporate the 1964 Census of Agriculture farm size, acreage, and value data. These estimates will be revised again to take into account the findings of a benchmark survey to be conducted in 1971.

Estimates of the percentage changes in real property taxes for a particular State were calculated in the following way. First, all farms within the State were grouped into the farm size categories used in the census of agriculture, and the average tax per acre was calculated for each farm size group for each of the previous 2 years. The tax per acre for each acreage size group was then multiplied by an estimate of the acreage in the size class. Total farm real estate taxes were then found by adding the taxes of all size groups together. This sum was then divided by the number of acres in the State, producing an estimate of the State tax per acre for each year. The percentage change between the 2 years was then calculated and applied to the previous year's estimate of taxes per acre to obtain the current year's estimated tax per acre.

Taxes per \$100 of full value and taxes as a percentage of net and gross farm income are also calculated and published annually for each State. In addition, national and regional averages are derived from the State estimates through the use of weighted averages.
