
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
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HOGS AND PIGS

Revised Estimates, 1965-69

Inventories, Value, Sows farrowed, Pig crop, Number of hog farms

This publication presents a record of the revised estimates of the Crop Reporting Board, Statistical Reporting Service, relating to:

- Number and classes of hogs March 1, June 1, September 1 and December 1, 1965-69.
- Number and value of hogs, January 1, 1966-69 and December 1, 1967-69.
- Sows farrowed and pig crops, 1965-69.
- Number of hog farms, 1965-69.

It continues and combines the official series on Hogs and Pigs previously shown in the following separate publications:

Estimates for the period released currently in quarterly and annual reports were based primarily on survey returns from hog producers. Later these estimates were reviewed in relationship to slaughter records and revised when necessary. For this publication all of the above indications plus an analysis of the 1969 U. S. Census of Agriculture were considered.

In 1964, the U. S. Census of Agriculture was enumerated mostly during November and December, and farmers were asked to report inventories on the date of enumeration. In using census data it was necessary to adjust from the average date of enumeration to December 1. In contrast to survey methods used for the 1964 and earlier Censuses, the 1969 Census of Agriculture was collected by mail with survey procedures modified by the level of the individual farm value of sales. The initial questionnaire mailing reached producers in early 1970 with the request to report inventories as of December 31, 1969. Several followup mailings were made to obtain as complete coverage as possible. The average date that census questionnaires were completed was during February. Therefore, different adjustments were necessary for the 1969 Census than for earlier census data.

At the national level, revisions were less than 1 percent for all hogs and pigs as well as sows farrowing. In the major hog producing States, revisions were generally few and minor. In some less important States an evaluation of all data indicated some changes were necessary in the 1969 estimates. In a few States where the error had accumulated since 1965, the last benchmark period, minor changes were made as far back as 1966. These changes had no significant effect on the national totals during these early years.

For States that have less than 10,000 hogs or less than 10,000 sows farrowed, the estimates are rounded to the nearest 100 head. For all other States estimates of inventories, sows farrowing and pig crops are rounded to the nearest 1,000 head.

The following changes in the series took place during the 1965-69 period.

1. Monthly farrowing estimates were changed from State to regional estimates in 1965 and regional estimates discontinued beginning with March 1968 in quarterly States and December 1967 for all other States.
2. Quarterly estimates of farrowings for all States were published starting in 1968 and for this publication the historical series was compiled starting in 1965 based on monthly estimates.
3. June 1 inventory estimates for all States were first published in June 1968 with the series beginning with 1964.
4. January 1 inventory and value estimates were discontinued after 1969 and December 1 inventory values initiated in 1970 with the series beginning with 1967.
