


INTRODUCTION

The indices of agricultural production in this publication were prepared as a part of a continuing assessment of the current agricultural situation abroad. The formula for the country indices is Laspeyres's base-weighted aggregative formula. The weights are estimates of 1961-65 average prices received by farmers, expressed in U.S. dollars per metric ton. The regional indices were computed for the sums of the country aggregates for the various regions. This method involves a bias favoring countries with relatively comprehensive commodity coverage or relatively high price weights, but this bias is normally not serious enough to offset the advantage of flexibility in the grouping of countries into various alternative regions (e.g., the Caribbean and Central America). Indices of food production were computed from aggregates covering edible products which contribute energy to the diet, regardless of the extent to which they are actually used for food. Coffee is, therefore, excluded from the indices of food production. Per capita indices were computed by dividing the country or regional indices of total production by appropriate indices of population (1961-65 = 100).

To avoid double counting of livestock products and feed in certain countries, a constant fraction of the aggregate value of output of livestock products has been subtracted. This constant percentage represents the base period average relation between the value of livestock products and the value (at 1961-65 price weights) of quantities of crops and derived products (bran, oilcake, molasses, beet pulp) used for feed in 1961-65. This method treats a nation's agriculture as though it consisted of two farms: one producing and selling nothing but crops, and the other producing livestock products buying all feed except pasture. It may overvalue feed by applying a price which refers to qualities of crops used for human consumption to the crops fed, but if this is the case, the overvaluation of the crops needs to be offset by the feed deduction.

Meat data are on a carcass weight basis--including slaughter of domestic and imported livestock--except where commercial slaughter only is indicated. Data for mutton include goat meat. Data for milk include goat milk when available.

For a few countries, in which the value of foreign trade in live cattle is significant relative to the value of total agricultural production, the value (at 1961-65 average prices) of live cattle exports has been added and the value of live cattle imports has been subtracted. This procedure is considered preferable to adjusting the statistics on production of meat to reflect the national production of live animals. Allowances have not been made for countries which have insignificant international trade in live animals.

Statistics on production of most products were received from the Foreign Agricultural Service (FAS). When figures from FAS were unavailable, data were compiled from official publications or from reports and publications of FAO and other international organizations. In a few cases, in the absence of other data, the ESCS country specialist has made his own estimates based on past trends and his knowledge of the situation; such figures are naturally subject to error. Most of the production

estimates for 1977 used in this publication were received from FAS before February 14, but a few were received later; all are preliminary.

The time reference is the calendar year in which the bulk of the crop is harvested, with the exceptions noted below. Data for coffee and cocoa beans for all countries refer to the marketing years beginning in the indicated calendar years, even though most or all of the harvest occurs between January 1 and the end of the marketing year (e.g., cocoa beans in Trinidad and Tobago, and in Venezuela).

The reader should note that the production figures in this publication differ from those published by FAS with respect to cotton in Brazil, Colombia, and Peru, because in each case there are separate figures for output of distinct portions of the crop harvest of a given year with the late harvest of the previous year, while here they have been left on a calendar year basis.

The reader is cautioned against misinterpretation of the aggregates, which are shown in "million dollars at constant prices." These aggregates are published for the convenience of users who may wish to calculate the effect of revisions in the estimates of production. The aggregates do not measure the gross value of agricultural production, gross sales by farmers, or the farming component of the gross domestic product, although changes from year to year in the aggregates may be correlated with similar changes in those other series. Readers and users of these indices are cautioned against using the products listed by each country as its total food supply. The list does not include all food or fiber grown in the country. Also output of some crops and products are exported and not available for domestic use.

Under a continuing arrangement, the United States Agency for International Development (AID) provided some financial assistance in researching and preparing the production indices presented in this publication.

The Economics, Statistics, and Cooperatives Service has revised the indices of agricultural production, which appear in this publication, to reflect changes recently made in foreign grain production for the last 25 years. The grain production data were revised in part to more closely agree with data published by foreign governments. These indices supersede those published in Statistical Bulletin Nos. 136 and 569 and all previous editions, published annually for 1964 through 1973 as ERS-Foreign Report No. 264.
