


IN EUROPE AND THE U.S.S.R.
Average 1961-65 and Annual 1969 through 1978

INTRODUCTION

Europe and the U.S.S.R. produce and consume a large share of the world's food and fiber. Assessment of the agricultural and food situation in these areas is basic to a knowledge of world production, consumption, and trade in food and fibers. The indices presented in this publication are a part of the continuing effort of the Economics, Statistics, and Cooperatives Service (ESCS) to assess the world agricultural situation.

The country indices are calculated by Laspeyres' base-weighted aggregate formula. The weights used in Eastern Europe and the Soviet Union are estimates of the 1961-65 average prices received by farmers in Western Europe, and for West European countries they are the average base period prices received by farmers in each of the individual countries, expressed in U.S. dollars per metric ton. Regional indices are computed from sums of country aggregates.

A portion of each country's aggregate value of livestock output is subtracted to avoid double counting of feed and the livestock products produced from it. This share represents the estimated relationship between the value of livestock products and the value of feeds (not including forage), whether produced domestically or imported, as calculated for the base period years 1961-65. This feed deduction is a constant percentage and thus does not express year-to-year variations in feed actually fed. Unless there is a large change in livestock output relative to crop production, the feed deduction has little, if any, effect on the resulting index.

Most production data are official statistics of the respective countries or other international organizations. In a few cases, when data were unavailable, estimates were made by ESCS specialists.

Only those agricultural products of considerable significance in the respective countries are included. Production data are listed under the year in which the bulk of the harvest occurred.

Indices of food production are computed from the total aggregates of all food items listed, whether actually consumed or not. The list does not include all food grown or consumed in the country; therefore, it is not a measure of total calories consumed. Also, some output of crops and products is exported and not available for domestic use. Excluded from the food indices are fibers, tea, and tobacco.

Per capita indices are computed by dividing the agricultural or food indices by appropriate indices of population.

The production aggregates showing value in millions of dollars at constant 1961-65 West European producer prices should not be confused with gross value of agricultural production, gross sales by farmers, or agriculture's contribution to gross national product because a different average or current price may have been used and farm product sales would likely be more inclusive than the production aggregates. The aggregates permit year-to-year comparisons of the level of output in the various countries and the region. Trends in these aggregates should roughly parallel trends in total agricultural production.

These European countries customarily publish indices of the gross value of agricultural production using their own price weights and base years. These two factors plus differences in valuing meat production, changes in numbers of livestock, seed deductions,

and variations in commodity coverage are the major reasons for the deviations between ESCS/USDA indices of agricultural production and those published by the respective foreign countries.

Data appearing in these tables are those available to the Economics, Statistics, and Cooperatives Service, prior to March 15, 1979, and supersede ERS-608 and any previous indices reports.
