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


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

ABSTRACT

Total agricultural production in Asia and Oceania during 1979 declined 3 percent from the record 1978 output, while per capita output dropped 5 percent. Of the 14 countries for which indices of agricultural production are calculated, 4 showed increases, 8 showed decreases, and 2 remained unchanged. India and Japan (the major agricultural producing countries of the region) suffered declines of 8 and 6 percent, respectively. Per capita food production was up 3 percent in South Asia, 5 percent in East Asia, and 12 percent in Oceania, compared with the 1961-65 average.

INTRODUCTION

Indices of agricultural production in foreign countries have been prepared since World War II as part of a continuing assessment of the current agricultural situation abroad. During and immediately after the war the effort focused on Europe. Since the midfifties, special attention has been given to the less developed countries because of an arrangement with the Agency for International Development, whereby the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) prepares annual reports on the volume of agricultural production in most countries that are aid recipients.

The indices presented on the following pages are constructed from production series given in metric tons, extending from 1970 through 1979, inclusive. To the extent possible, commodities were combined on a calendar year basis. Calendar year production includes crops harvested during the spring, summer, and autumn of 1970 (for example) and includes some crops such as rice where the bulk of the crop is harvested in 1970, but continued into the early part of 1971. The base period is the average of the calendar years 1961-65. The indices in this report supersede those published in the May 1979 Indices of Agricultural Production for Asia and Oceania, Statistical Bulletin No. 619 and all previous editions.

The reader is cautioned against using the products listed by each country as its total food supply. The list does not include all food or fiber grown in the country. Also, output of some crops and products is exported and not available for domestic use.

Country Indices. Country indices are calculated with Laspeyres' base-weighted aggregate formula. Estimated base-period average prices received by farmers, expressed in U.S. dollars per metric ton, are used for weighting. When farm prices are not available it is necessary to use wholesale or export prices, adjusting to make them comparable to farm level.

Source of Data. These indices are based on statistics of widely differing reliability. For most commodities, forecasts of production in the current year are published by the Foreign Agricultural Service (FAS). These forecasts cover the major producing countries and are subsequently revised by the governments concerned or by USDA. For other commodities (e.g., millet, sorghum, bananas, and cassava), FAS does not publish production statistics and ESCS must rely on other sources, such as Food and Agriculture Organization and foreign governments, for historical data and on estimates, based largely on trends, for the current year. Statistics of livestock products are generally less reliable than figures for output of the principal commercial crops. All production figures are based on the latest information available as of the end of March 1980.

Regional Indices. Indices of agricultural production are computed for three regions: South Asia, East Asia, and Oceania, and totals for each region are included in the tables. Several smaller countries are omitted from the calculations for lack of data. The formula for the regional indices is a weighted-aggregative type, the regional aggregates being the sums of the country aggregates. This method is biased in favor of countries with relatively comprehensive commodity coverage or relatively high price weights, but the bias is not serious enough to offset the advantage of great flexibility in the grouping of countries into various alternative regions and subregions.

Commodity Coverage. In the country indices all major cash crops and subsistence crops are included if current production estimates are available. Hay and other crops grown for feeding on the farm are omitted. Output of milk, eggs, poultry meat, wool, honey, and fur skins, if significant, is included to the extent permitted by the quality of the data. Production of meat animals is represented for most countries by estimates of meat production.

Commodity Prices. Prices of agricultural commodities are generally reported in local currencies. Converting the U.S. dollar poses a problem. The currencies of many less developed countries are overvalued in varying degrees in the base-period 1961-65. To convert with exchange rates at par value would give an unrealistic schedule of prices in U.S. dollars. Prices would be too high in proportion to the extent of currency depreciation. This would not affect the computation of an index for a given country, but it would cause difficulty when combining production

of several countries to obtain a regional index. Thus, conversion of prices to U.S. dollars, using free market exchange rates rather than official rates, offers a more standard basis for regional analysis. For this reason, prices in countries included in this publication are converted to U.S. dollars using free market rates reported in Hong Kong. The exchange rates employed are gathered on a monthly basis and averaged over the 5-year 1961-65 base period.

Feed Deduction. For Australia and Japan, the indices of agricultural production regard agriculture as consisting essentially of two farms: one which produces only crops and no live-stock; and one which produces livestock products from pasture and forage, together with feed either produced domestically or imported. Aggregates are shown separately for crops and live-stock, referring to the gross output of these two farms. When these two aggregates are combined, a deduction is made for livestock feed to avoid double counting of feed and the livestock products produced from it. This deduction is a fixed percentage of the livestock aggregates and represents the feed purchased by the national livestock farm.

The fixed percentage deduction for feed was derived by dividing the feed bill for the base period (1961-65) by the gross value of livestock output in the same years. The feed bill for the base period was calculated by applying to the grains, potatoes, and other crops fed, the prices received by farmers, with no markup for transportation or compounding. In the case of byproduct feeds, such as bran, oilcake, molasses, and brewers' grains, estimates of prices paid by farmers were used.

Food Production Indices. Index numbers of food production are computed for all countries and all regions. They are derived from the index numbers of agricultural production and differ only by the exclusion of inedible commodities and of coffee, tea, and spices.
