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




INDICES OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION IN AFRICA AND THE NEAR EAST, 1970-79.

ABSTRACT

Indices of total and per capita agricultural and food production for Africa and the Near East are presented for the base period 1961-65 and annually for 1970-79. Data for population, agricultural production, and aggregates of agricultural and food production are also included. Country indices are calculated by Laspeyres' base-weighted aggregate formula.

INTRODUCTORY NOTES

Indices of agricultural production in foreign countries are prepared as part of a continuing assessment of the current agricultural situation abroad. The country indices are calculated by Laspeyres' base-weighted aggregative formula. They are constructed from production series given in thousands of metric tons. The time reference is the calendar year in which the bulk of the crop is harvested or, in some cases, notably coffee and cocoa beans, the marketing year beginning in the indicated calendar year.

The base period for the indices is the average of calendar years 1961-65. The weights are estimated base period average prices received by farmers expressed in U.S. dollars per metric ton. A separate schedule for price weights is used for each country.

Indices for individual countries are based on statistics from various sources, and of widely differing reliability. Statistics of livestock products generally are not as reliable as figures for the output of the principal commercial crops. Periodic commodity reports published by the Foreign Agricultural Service give data for the most recent years. This source is supplemented by publications of foreign governments and international organizations such as the Food and Agriculture Organization, particularly for historical statistics. In some cases, in the absence of other data, the ESCS country specialist has made his own estimates based on past trends and his knowledge of the country situation.

Country indices include all major cash crops and subsistence crops for which current estimates of production are obtainable. Hay and other crops grown for feeding on the farm have been omitted. Outputs of milk, eggs, and wool have been included to the extent permitted by the quality of the data. Production of meat animals is represented for a number of countries by estimates of

meat production, with allowances for imports or exports of live cattle in some countries, but with no adjustment for changes in the number of animals in the national herd or in the average live weight of animals. Considering the great importance of meat animals and the defects in current estimates of meat production, the present practice is recognized as subject to substantial improvement. No allowance is made for sales of work animals from the farming sector to other sectors of the economy.

To calculate the indices for each country, the production of each commodity is multiplied by its price weight and the resulting aggregates are summed for each year. (Note that since the weights are actual prices, the aggregates that appear in the following tables are values of production in million U.S. dollars.) The total aggregate for a given year is then divided by the average aggregate for the base period (1961-65) to obtain the index number. The per capita indices for each country are calculated by dividing the indices of total agricultural production by the population indices. Food production indices are calculated similarly, and differ only by the exclusion of inedible commodities, coffee, tea, and spices.

To avoid double counting of livestock products and feed in certain countries, a portion of the aggregate value of output of livestock products has been subtracted to determine total agricultural output. In deriving this deduction, the agriculture of each country is regarded as consisting essentially of two farms: one with no livestock which produces only crops, and one with grazing land but no crops which produces livestock products from pasture and from feed purchased either from the domestic crop farm or from abroad. Aggregates are published separately for crops and livestock, referring to the gross

output of these two farms. When these two aggregates are combined, a deduction is made in certain countries for livestock feed. This deduction is a fixed percentage of the livestock aggregate and represents the feed purchased by the national livestock farm. The concept of agricultural production--gross production of crops plus value added by livestock--thus resembles the index of net U.S. agricultural production used by ESCS.

The fixed percentage deduction for feed was derived by dividing the feed bill for the base period by the gross value of livestock output in the same years. The feed bill for the base period was calculated by applying to the grains, potatoes, and other crops fed the prices received by farmers, with no markup for transportation or compounding. In the case of byproduct feeds, such as bran, oilcake, molasses, and brewers' grains, estimates of prices paid by farmers were used.

A subindex for crops is published. When divided by an index of cropland harvested it provides a measure of changes over time in output per acre. This is not an index of yields, since the relative importance of the different crops is not held constant.

No subindex of livestock production is published because of the inadequate coverage already mentioned. A researcher could easily compute such a subindex from the published aggregates of livestock production, but it is hoped that the very act of examining the commodity content of those aggregates would convey to the researcher an understanding of their inadequacy.

The reader is cautioned against misinterpreting the aggregates; these are shown in "millions of dollars at constant prices." The aggregates may be used to calculate the effects of revisions in the estimates of production. Not all crops and livestock

products produced in a country are listed. Only those crops and livestock products with significant production or those for which reasonable estimates of production could be made were used. Therefore, the aggregates do not measure the gross value of agricultural production, gross sales by farmers, or the farming component of the gross domestic product, although year-to-year changes in the aggregates may be correlated with similar changes in those other series.

The reader is also cautioned against misinterpretation of the indices of total food production and per capita food production. The entire output of an edible commodity is used in the index calculation regardless of the share consumed in the country or the share entering commercial channels for export or other use. Therefore, the index may not accurately reflect the domestic availability of food in a country or region.

The regional indices are computed from the sums of the country aggregates for the various regions. This method involves a bias favoring countries with relatively comprehensive commodity coverage or relatively high price weights, but this bias normally is not serious enough to offset the advantage of great flexibility in the grouping of countries into various alternative regions.


