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

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

U.S. RICE DISTRIBUTION UPDATE, by Shelby H. Holder, Jr. and David Martella. National Economics Division; Economics, Statistics, and Cooperatives Service; U.S. Department of Agriculture. Statistical Bulletin No. 640.

ABSTRACT

Rice mills and repackagers distributed 27.1 million hundredweight (cwt) of milled rice for domestic use in 1978/79, up from about 20.4 million cwt in 1975/76, according to this study of recent U.S. rice distribution patterns. The three major outlets are direct food use, processed foods, and beer, which accounted for record levels of 15.2, 3.7, and 8.2 million cwt in 1978/79, respectively. Per capita consumption of rice as a direct food is 6.9 pounds, compared to 6.2 pounds in 1975/76. The latest figure becomes 12 pounds when processed food and beer uses are added.

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SUMMARY

Distribution of U.S. rice for all major uses reached record levels in 1978/79. Domestic distribution was 27.1 million cwt, up from about 20.4 million cwt in 1975/76. Shipments for the three major domestic uses in 1978/79--direct food, processed foods, and beer--were 15.2 cwt, 3.7 cwt, and 8.2 cwt, respectively.

The record 1978/79 direct food use pushed U.S. per capita consumption to 6.9 pounds, compared to 6.2 pounds in 1975/76. The per capita use was slightly over 12 pounds when use in processed foods and beer was included.

Regular milled long grain rice continued to be the most popular direct food use, accounting for 70 percent of the 15.2 million cwt distributed in 1978/79. Parboiled rice was the first ranked specialty rice, with 1.8 million cwt distributed in 1978/79, up 5 percent from 1975/76.

Use of rice package mixes surpassed the 1-million-cwt level in 1978/79, more than a threefold increase from 1975/76. Breakfast cereals, however, continued to be the top processed food use.

Rice distributed for direct food use was up in all major U.S. regions, except New England. The Pacific and Middle Atlantic regions ranked first and second, respectively, in total rice distribution for direct food use.

Rice sold for direct food use was distributed in larger packages. The percentage of rice distributed in packages under 5 pounds fell from 41 in 1975/76 to 30 in 1978/79.

INTRODUCTION

Americans are eating more rice: 6.9 pounds per person last year compared to 6.2 pounds just 4 years ago. Total U.S. rice distributed exceeded 27 million cwt in the 1978/79 marketing year, up significantly since 1975/76. These and other trends are identified in the latest of 12 periodic surveys of U.S. rice distribution patterns, the earliest in 1955/56.

The current study provides distribution data from the 1975/76 and 1978/79 marketing years. ^{1/} Distribution by type of rice and rice specialty product, State and region, package size, and origin of shipment is described. Data were provided by mills and repackagers representing about 95 percent of the rice shipped in the survey years. The Rice Millers' Association and the Rice Council cooperated in the survey.

DISTRIBUTION TO MAJOR DOMESTIC OUTLETS

U.S. rice mills and repackagers distributed record amounts of rice to direct food use, food processors, and beer brewers in 1978/79 (table 1).

Direct Food Use

Direct food use accounts for up to two-thirds of the rice consumed domestically. Such direct food distribution reached a record level of more than 15 million cwt in 1978/79, up 17 percent from 1975/76 distribution (table 1). About 19 percent was specialty rice; the rest was regular milled white rice, Americans' favorite table rice. Sixty percent of the 3 million cwt of specialty rice distributed was parboiled, 32 percent was precooked, while most of the balance was brown rice (table 2).

About 75 percent of the rice shipped for direct food use was enriched in 1978/79 and 1975/76 by some form of vitamin additive (tables 4 and 5). The most common additive was a powder form containing thiamin, niacin, and iron.

Processed Food Use

Principal uses for rice in processed foods were cereals, package mixes, soups, and baby foods. A record 3.7 million cwt of rice were used in these products in 1978/79, up from the 2.8 million used in 1975/76 (tables 6 and 7). Package mixes led the increase.

Beer

The 8.2 million cwt of rice used in beer brewing in 1978/79 accounted for 30 percent of total U.S. domestic rice use. Significantly lower prices for rice used by brewers contributed to the record use. Beer processors use lower priced brokens in their brewing formula when ample supplies are available. Whole grain rice is used when brokens are in short supply or unavailable. All shipments to beer processors in 1978/79 were reported as brokens (table 6).

DISTRIBUTION BY REGION, TYPE, AND PACKAGE SIZE

The Pacific and Middle Atlantic regions accounted for about 48 percent of the rice distributed for direct food use in 1978/79 (table 8). New York and New Jersey accounted for most of the use in the Middle Atlantic region (table 10). Florida accounted for 40 percent of the direct food use in the South Atlantic region, followed by South Carolina with 18 percent.

U.S. per capita consumption in 1978/79 compared to 1975/76 was up in five out of nine of the major geographical regions (tables 8 and 9). The Pacific and West South Central regions ranked first and second among regions in per capita consumption.

Long grain remained the most popular U.S. table rice, accounting for two-thirds or more of the total direct food use (tables 10 and 11). Medium grain accounted for most of the remainder, with short grain use being about 1 to 2 percent of the total. The amount of rice distributed via most package sizes increased, but this was not true for packages under 5 pounds (tables 10 and 11).

SHIPMENTS TO TERRITORIES AND FOR EXPORT

Shipments to U.S. territories in 1978/79 were 3.5 million cwt, down from 1975/76 (tables 12 and 13). Puerto Rico accounted for over 94 percent of the total for both years. Short grain was the main type shipped to Puerto Rico, but the latest data show increases in the medium and long grain shares. The package size of most of the rice shipped to U.S. territories was less than 5 pounds.

Thirty-six U.S. rice mills reported export shipments of 47.6 million cwt in 1978/79. Proportional shares by long, medium, and short were 77, 19, and 4 percent, respectively.

MILL ORIGIN AND DESTINATION

Forty-five mills processed rice in 1978/79. The major rice milling centers were Houston, Tex.; Stuttgart, Ark.; Sacramento, Calif.; and Crowley, La. Texas and Arkansas mills processed about 70 percent of the U.S. crop; rice distribution from these States dominated domestic and export outlets.

Arkansas-Mississippi

The Arkansas-Mississippi mill area ranked first in rice distribution to processors, with 57 percent of the distribution in 1978/79 (excluding beer), up from 48 percent in 1975/76 (tables 14 and 15). This mill area accounted for about half of the rice distributed to beer processors in 1978/79 (table 14) and ranked second to Texas in distribution of rice for direct food use. One-third of the Arkansas-Mississippi mills shipments of rice for direct food use was distributed to the Middle Atlantic region in 1978/79 and 1975/76 (tables 16 and 17).

Louisiana

Exports accounted for the major share of the rice distribution from Louisiana rice mills. Mills in this State accounted for a relatively small share of the rice distributed for U.S. direct food use. Most of the shipments to direct food use went to the Middle Atlantic and West South Central regions (table 18).

Louisiana was an important supplier to Puerto Rico, shipping 473,000 cwt in 1978/79, up 15 percent from the 412,000 cwt in 1975/76 (tables 20 and 21). Most of Louisiana's shipments to territories were medium grain.

Texas

Texas mills, and their affiliated mills, accounted for 45 percent of the rice shipments for direct food use in 1978/79 (table 22). Among Southern States, Texas accounted for the largest share of shipments to territories in 1978/79 and 1975/76 (tables 20 and 21). Most of the shipments were medium grain.

The South's importance as a rice supplier to territories increased, both in quantity and in proportional share. Southern mills shipped 989,000 cwt or about 26 percent of the total shipments to territories in 1975/76. Shipments increased to 1.4 million cwt in 1978/79, a 45-percent increase over 1975/76 (tables 20 and 21).

California

California mills supplied the largest percentage of U.S. shipments to Puerto Rico, shipping 1.9 million cwt in 1978/79, 58 percent of all U.S. shipments to this territory (table 20). This was a decrease from the 2.7 million cwt in 1975/76 (table 21). In addition to ranking first in shipments to territories, California's shipments to Hawaii accounted for most of the U.S. rice supplied to Hawaii.

Of all the rice received for direct food use in the Pacific region in 1978/79, 59 percent of the total was supplied by California mills, most of which was medium grain (table 24). Approximately half of the 3.6 million cwt of rice consumed for direct food use in the Pacific region in 1978/79 was long grain, of which Texas was the primary supplier (table 22).

California's 2.1 million cwt shipment to beer processors in 1978/79 made it the second largest supplier for this use (table 14).
