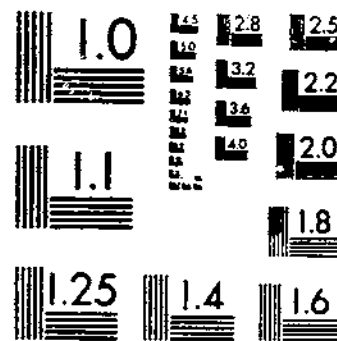

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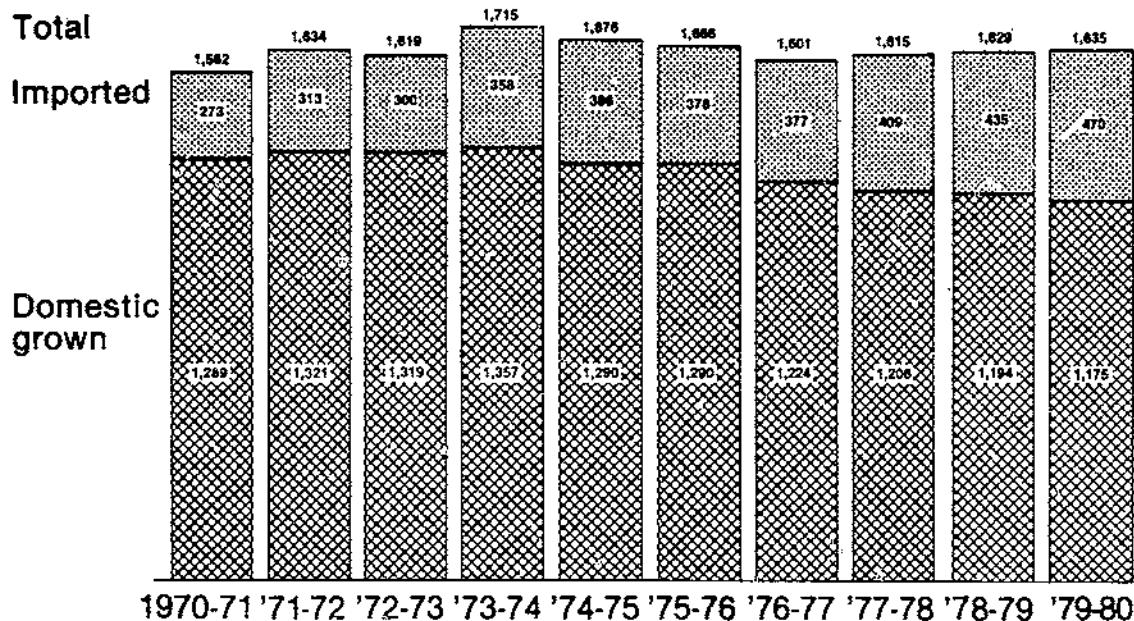
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Leaf Tobacco Disappearance in U.S.

Million lb. (farm sales weight)

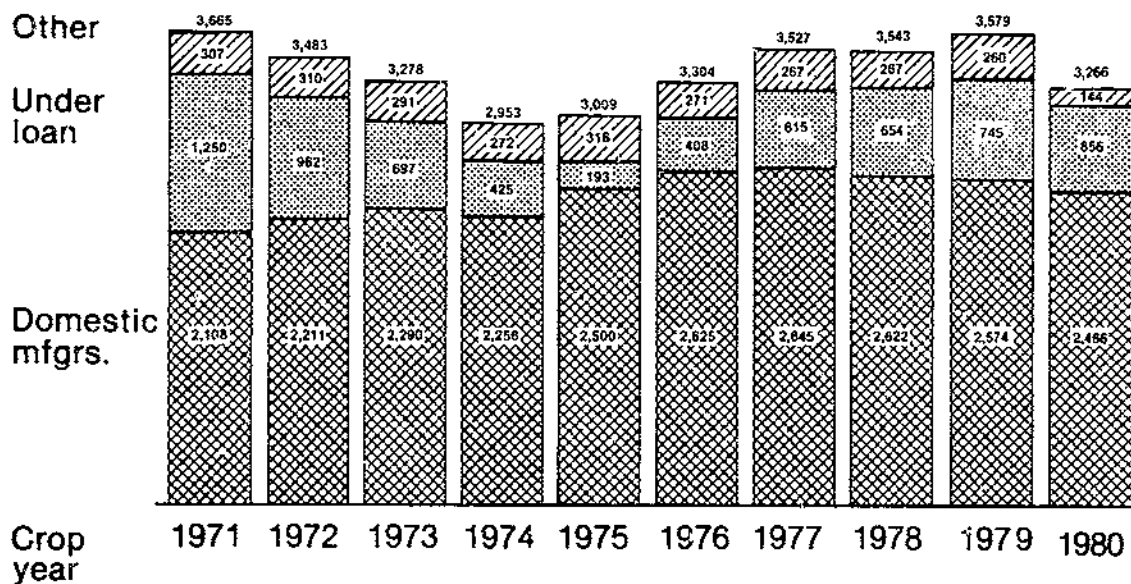


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Total Carryover Stocks U.S. Tobacco Types 11-62

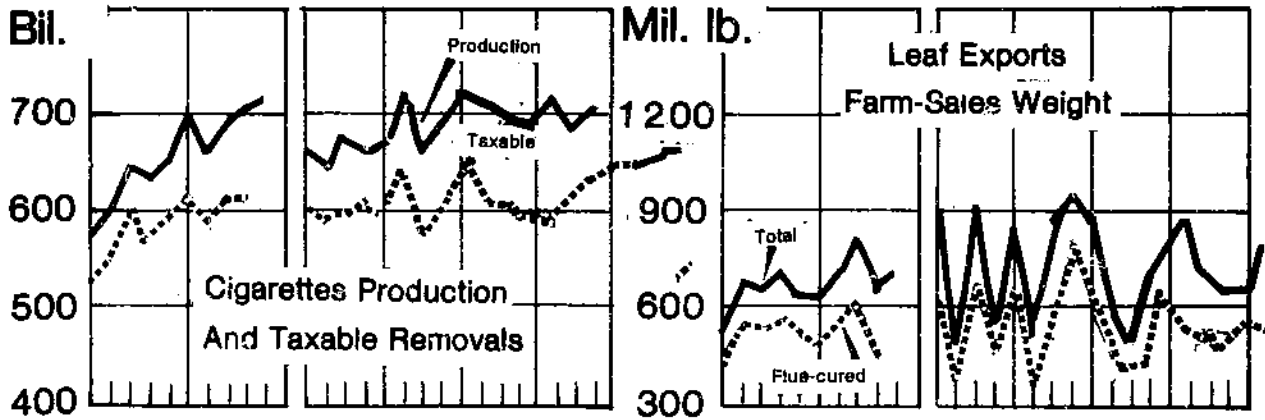


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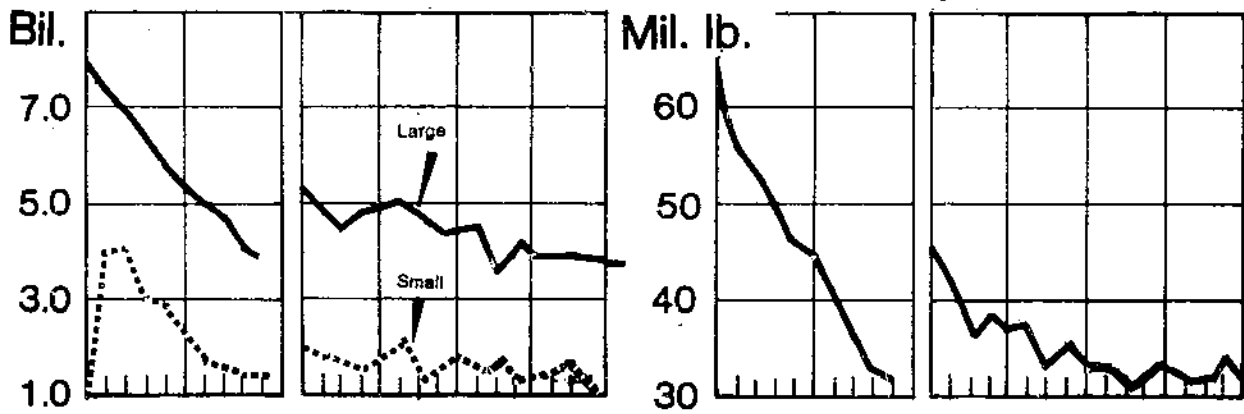

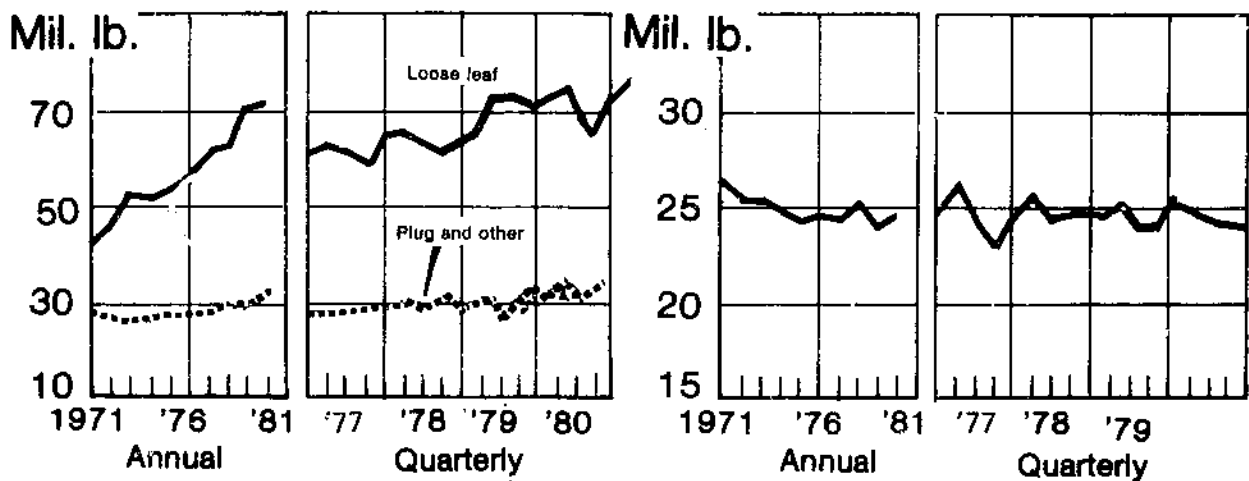
