### Abstract

This publication contains final cattle and cattle on feed estimates, including some revisions, made by the Agricultural Statistics Board for the period 1989-1993. This report continues the official series published in Statistical Bulletin No. 798, issued January 1990. Data covered include annual and semi-annual estimates by classes for cattle inventory and calf crop. Number of operations, operation and inventory by size group estimates are also included. Final estimates of cattle on feed for all States as of January 1, quarterly estimates for 13 major feeding States, and monthly estimates for 7 States are also included. Estimates contained in this publication provide a historical record and benchmark for current estimates.

### Introduction

Cattle and cattle on feed estimates were published on a current basis during 1989-93 in monthly, quarterly and annual reports. Primary data used in preparing the current cattle estimates were obtained from producers using probability surveys. Survey procedures ensured that all cattle and cattle on feed producers, regardless of size, had a chance to be included in the survey. Large producers were sampled more heavily than small operations. Information was collected by mail, telephone, and face-to-face personal interviews. Since all operations raising cattle are not included in the sample, survey estimates are subject to sampling variability. This variability, as measured by the relative standard error, is about 1 percent at the U.S. level for the cattle inventory. This means that chances are approximately 95 out of 100 that a survey estimate will be within 2 percent of the complete coverage value if the same procedures are used to survey all producers. Survey results are also subject to non-sampling errors such as omissions, duplication, and mistakes in reporting, recording, and processing the data. The effects of these errors cannot be measured directly. They are minimized through rigid quality controls in the data collection process and through a careful review of all reported data for consistency and reasonableness. Lists of cattle producers are updated annually in each State prior to sampling.

The Agricultural Statistics Board (ASB) also constructs a U.S. balance sheet for an additional check on inventory estimates. The balance sheet begins with the previous inventory estimate, adds estimates of births and imports, and subtracts estimates of slaughter, exports, and deaths. This indicated ending inventory level is compared to the ASB estimate for reasonableness.

Revisions were made only after a thorough review of the original data, with consideration given to all additional data now available, including the 1992 Census of Agriculture. At the national level, downward revisions of cattle inventory estimates ranged from 1.4 to 2.5 percent.
