Personal report Biography of Stephan von Cramon-Taubadel

Editor-in-Chief of Agricultural Economics, Vol. 24 onwards

Since 1998 Stephan von Cramon is Professor of Agricultural Policy at the University of Göttingen. He was born in Ottawa, Canada in 1962. He received a Bachelor's degree in Agricultural Economics from McGill University (MacDonald College) in 1984, a Master's degree from the University of Manitoba in 1986, and a Ph.D. and Habilitation both from the University of Kiel in 1992 and 1998, respectively. He has taught Agricultural Economics and Econometrics at the Universities of Kiel and Rostock as well as at the Humboldt University in Berlin.

Since 1996 Stephan von Cramon has been a member of the German Advisory Group on Economic Reform with the Government of Ukraine, responsible for agricultural policy reform. In this capacity he has authored and co-authored numerous papers

and policy briefs on various aspects of economic and agricultural reform in Ukraine. He has also edited two books on agriculture in Ukraine, the second of which is to appear in mid-2001. From 1994 to 1998 he was Book Review Editor of the *European Review of Agricultural Economics*.
