# APPENDICES

## APPENDIX I

### THE INDIAN SOCIETY OF AGRICULTURAL ECONOMICS

#### CONSTITUTION

1. The name of the Society shall be "The Indian Society of Agricultural Economics."
2. The objects of the Society shall be to promote the investigation, study and improvement of the economic and social conditions of agriculture and rural life.

These objects shall be pursued by :—

- (a) holding periodical Conferences for the discussion of problems ;
- (b) publishing papers or summaries of papers, either separately or collectively, or in a periodical which may be issued under the auspices of the Society ;
- (c) co-operating with other institutions having similar objects, such as the International Conference of Agricultural Economists and the Indian Economic Association ;
- (d) any other means which the Society may decide.

3. The Society shall consist of (a) Members, (b) Honorary Members, and (c) Member-Institutions, who are interested in the economic and social conditions of agriculture and rural life.

Candidates for Membership shall be nominated by any two Members of the Society and admitted to membership on being approved by the Executive Committee.

Candidates for Honorary Membership shall be nominated by the Executive Committee and elected by a majority of Members present and voting at a General Meeting of the Society.

Institutions wishing to become members shall apply to the Executive Committee and will be admitted to Membership on its approval.

Members and Member-Institutions shall pay to the Society an annual subscription of Rs. 12/-. The composition of subscription for Life-Membership shall be Rs. 250/-.

Member-Institutions shall be entitled to send only one representative to the Conferences and Meetings and shall not be entitled to the composition of subscription for Life-Membership.

4. Except as otherwise provided in the Constitution, the business of the Society shall be conducted by the Executive Committee.

5. The Office-bearers of the Society shall be a President, three Vice-Presidents, an Honorary Secretary-Treasurer and an Honorary Joint-Secretary if appointed.

The Executive Committee of the Society shall consist of:-

- (1) The President,
- (2) three Vice-Presidents,
- (3) an Honorary. Secretary-Treasurer,
- (4) an Honorary Joint-Secretary (if appointed), and
- (5) nine Members.

The President and in his absence one of the Vice-Presidents present, shall preside at the Executive Committee Meetings.

The Office-bearers and the Executive Committee shall hold office till their successors are elected.

The Executive Committee shall fill any vacancies in the Committee occurring during their period of office.

6. The General Meetings of the Society shall ordinarily be held once a year. The time and place of such General Meetings shall be fixed by the Executive Committee and not less than twenty-eight days' notice of these General Meetings shall be given to all members, Hon. Members and Member-Institutions.

A Special General Meeting may be convened by the Executive Committee at any time and shall also be convened on the requisition of not less than twenty-five Members. Fourteen days' notice of such Special General Meeting shall be given.

The following business shall be transacted at the General Meetings :-

- (1) Consideration of the annual report and audited accounts.
- (2) Election of Office-bearers and the Executive Committee.
- (3) Election of Hon. Members if any.
- (4) Appointment of auditors.
- (5) Consideration of any proposed amendments to the Constitution, subject to Clause 7.
- (6) Other relevant business.

7. Any amendments intended to effect any alteration in the Constitution of the Society, shall be submitted in the form of a written notice of motion, to be circulated to Members, Hon. Members and Member-Institutions with the notice of a General Meeting and shall be considered at such General Meeting. Amendments shall be carried with two-thirds majority of the Members present at such General Meeting.

### 3. *The Annual Conference*

The Nineteenth (1958) Annual Conference of the Society was postponed because of the pre-occupation of the Society with the work of International Conference of Agricultural Economists held earlier in August-September, 1958 at Mysore. The subjects selected earlier for the Conference were retained for discussion at this Conference. In addition, a current topic was added. The subjects announced were as follows :

- (1) Taxation and Optimum Land Utilisation.
- (2) Role of Processing of Agriculture Produce in the Indian Rural Economy.
- (3) Technique of Evaluating Rural Development Programmes.
- (4) The Role of Agriculture in the Third Five-Year Plan.



#### 4. *Indian Journal of Agricultural Economics*

The following members of the Editorial Board elected to the Editorial Board of the Journal for 1958 continued to constitute the Board for 1959.

Five issues of the Journal were brought out in 1959. The first was the fourth issue of the Journal for 1958 brought out as a Special Number covering the deliberations of the 10th Session of the International Conference of Agricultural Economists in India. The Special Issue contained speeches delivered on the inaugural day of the Conference, summaries of the papers read at the Conference and the subsequent discussions on them, summaries of workshop discussions as well as a note on the Conference organisation. The first three regular issues of the Journal for 1959 were also published during the year. The Editorial Board decided to bring out the fourth issue of the Journal as a Special Number in honour of Sir Manilal B. Nanavati and it will be in the hands of the members by the end of this year.

#### 5. *International Conference of Agricultural Economists*

The work of the above Conference continued to engage us during the first quarter of the year under report. The accounts were finalised and the final Statement of Expenditure was submitted to the Ministry of Food and Agriculture, Government of India, in March, 1959. In the earlier report, it has been stated that the Government of India in the Ministry of Food and Agriculture, was good enough to render financial help for meeting the expenses of the International Conference. It sanctioned a grant of Rs. 2,50,000/- to the Society for the purpose. Members will be happy to find that the final statement of expenses as submitted to the Government showed a total expenditure of Rs. 2,09,385/- as against an estimated expenditure of Rs. 2,50,000/-. The Society has received Rs. 2,00,000/- and the balance of Rs. 9,385/- would be received from the Ministry in due course.

6. It is a matter of pride for all of us that Prof. D. G. Karve, the Vice-President of the Society has been elected the Regional Secretary, Asia, of the International Conference of Agricultural Economists at its last Session held in India. The office of the Society will handle this work also.

#### 7. *Publications*

(i) *Rural Sociology in India* : The Society published the second revised and enlarged edition of "Rural Sociology in India" in January, 1959. The edition has been sold out in less than a year. It has now been decided to bring out the third edition duly revised and expanded. It is hoped that the edition will be in the market before the middle of 1960.

(ii) *Co-operative Farming in Gujarat* : This book embodies the results of the working of the co-operative farming societies in Gujarat, prepared by the Gujarat Co-operative Farming Survey Committee, Ahmedabad. The Society was also associated with the study and rendered technical guidance and helped to finalise the report. The report was published by the Society at the instance of the Research Programmes Committee of the Planning Commission.

(iii) *The Report of the Seminar on Co-operative Farming* : The Report of the above Seminar held in Poona in May 1958 was completed and published under the Society's Seminar Series during the year under review.

(iv) *The Indian Rural Problem* : The Society has undertaken the revision of the Indian Rural Problem by Shri Manilal B. Nanavati and Shri J. J. Anjaria. Parts I and II of the book have already been printed. The third part is getting ready.

(v) *Retrospect* : The Society has completed 20 years of its career as an important All-India non-official research institution. The Retrospect giving an up-to-date account of the history and research as well as other academic activities of the Society has been prepared and published this month.

(vi) *Pimple Saudagar : A Resurvey* : The Society has agreed to provide a publication grant of Rs. 2,000/- to meet the cost of printing a research thesis entitled "Re-survey of a Deccan Village-Pimple Saudagar" by Shri P. D. Diskalkar of the Marathwada Agricultural College, Parbhani. The manuscript was extensively revised by the Society's Office under the guidance of Prof. M. L. Dantwala. It has now gone to the press.

### 8. *Research Schemes and Surveys*

(a) The Survey of the Evaluation of the Co-operative Movement in Karjan Taluka of the Baroda District was undertaken by the Society with a view to examining critically the progress of the Co-operative Movement in the Karjan Taluka, especially with a view to assessing the impact of the Movement on the economic and social life of the people. Most of the chapters of the report are ready. They are being finalised.

(b) Two proposals for further studies on (i) Land Reforms and (ii) Taluka Administration were submitted to the Regional Committee, Western Region, of the Research Programmes Committee. The proposals have been referred to the Committee of Direction on Land Reforms and the Committee of Direction of Problems of Political Science and Public Administration respectively. Their decisions are awaited before tentative schemes are worked out.

(c) *World Agricultural Economics and Rural Sociology Abstracts*: The Society has undertaken the work of preparing brief summaries of Indian articles and publications covering Agricultural Economics in its broadest sense, on behalf of the above quarterly Journal published by the International Association of Agricultural Librarians and Documentalists, Vienna, Austria. Accordingly, the abstracts are being sent to the Editorial Office every quarter. During the year, these abstracts were dispatched four times according to the requirements of the Editorial Office.

### 9. *Seminars*

The Executive Committee of the Society has approved two proposals for holding Seminars, one on "Methods for Evaluating Land Reforms in India" and the other on "The Cost of Production in Agriculture". The first proposal is received from the Research Programmes Committee of the Planning Commission and the second from the Indian Society of Agricultural Statistics. The first Seminar was to be held in October, 1959, but it was postponed at the instance of the Research Programmes Committee. The Society proposes to hold both the Seminars during 1960.

### 10. *Library*

Members are aware that the Society has a fairly well equipped Library. During the year nearly 410 books including pamphlets, reports and bound periodicals were added bringing the total number of books, etc., to 4170. The Library has been receiving about 100 periodicals in Agricultural Economics and allied subjects, quite a few from foreign countries in exchange of the issues of our Journal. Apart from serving as a clearing house of information and statistical data, it provides useful reference facilities to many, which are being availed of by several Government and semi-Government institutions as well as students of the Bombay University and our members.

### 11. *Prize Awards*

An announcement of the Prize Awards for the year 1958 was made in the April-June '59 issue of the Journal. Under the schemes of annual prize awards, the first prize for the year 1958 under Scheme No. I has been awarded to Shri A.S. Kahlon for the best research article on "Agricultural Planning and the Price System". Under Scheme No. II, the first prize was given to Shri A.S. Kahlon and Shri P. N. Saxena for the best paper of published research on "Economic Analysis of Bajra Fertilizer Rate Experiments." The second prize was given to Dr. P.C. Bansil for the paper on "Food Facts—An Analysis".

An announcement for the prize awards for the year 1959, has been made in the July-September, 1959 issue of the Journal. The following subjects and prizes have been announced for the year 1959.

- (i) Two prizes under Scheme No. I for best article on : "Obstacles in the Expansion of Agricultural Production."
- (ii) Two prizes under Scheme No. II for the best paper of published research in Agricultural Economics.

The last date for submitting the entries is 31st March, 1960.

### 12. *Membership*

1959 opened with a membership of 420. During the year 48 new members were enrolled and 22 ceased to be members. The number of members thus stand at 446 at the close of the year. The Society has 45 Donor-Members, 12 Honorary Members, 17 Life Members and 446 Ordinary Members, bringing the grand total to the gratifying figure of 520.

### 13. *Accounts*

The Society is grateful to the Government of India for renewing their usual grant of Rs. 50,000/- for the year 1959-60. The Balance-Sheet and Income and Expenditure Account for the 12-month period from 1st April, 1958 to 31st March, 1959, were published in the April-June, 1959 issue of the Journal.

We take this opportunity of conveying our grateful thanks to M/s. Dalal and Shah, Auditors and Accountants, Bombay, who were good enough to act as Honorary Auditors to our institution for the current year. In addition to the regular auditing work, now for 14 years, they readily acceded to our request to act as Hon. Auditors for the 10th International Conference of Agricultural Economists held at Mysore in 1958. Our special thanks are also due to them for guiding and ultimately helping us in finalising such complicated accounts involving large sums in record time.

14. It is a matter of satisfaction that the Society has been able to carry out its various activities with the valuable help of the Honorary workers whose active co-operation has always been an asset to this institution. The Society takes this opportunity of conveying sincere thanks to the members of the Executive Committee, Members of the Editorial Board of the Journal, Members of the Research Programmes Committee, and to all other members of the Society who have rendered valuable services during the year.

I will take this opportunity to particularly place on record the work of the members of the staff of the Society who have whole-heartedly co-operated and have discharged their duties efficiently and to our entire satisfaction. But for this assistance your Hon. Secretary would not have been able to handle the ever-mounting volume of work of your institution.
