## WORLD AGRICULTURAL ECONOMICS AND RURAL SOCIOLOGY ABSTRACTS

The World Agricultural Economics and Rural Sociology Abstracts is a quarterly international abstracts Journal edited in Vienna (Austria) and published from Amsterdam (Netherlands) by the International Association of Agricultural Librarians and Documentalists in co-operation with the International Association of Agricultural Economists. The Journal is intended to serve as an up-to-date guide to newly published books, reports and articles in periodicals which may be of interest to research workers, government officials, teachers, extension workers, etc., all over the world. The subjects covered in the Journal are agricultural economics in its broadest sense including governmental policies, land reforms, farm management, farm labour, farm accounting, marketing, credit, co-operation, etc., as well as allied topics such as rural sociology, agricultural education, legislation, geography and history.

The Journal gives short summaries outlining the essential contents or the main results of the investigations contained in the publications preceded by all the bibliographical details needed for their identification. The text of the bibliographical reference is given in the language of the original followed by an English translation if the original is in one of the less known languages. The material is presented in the Journal subject-wise and the number of subjects listed in the "Classification Scheme and Contents" of the Journal exceed 50. An alphabetical author index is appended to each number.

The Journal is published in March, June, September and December. A subject and a geographical index to each volume is published annually.

The Editorial Board of the Journal consists of eminent agricultural economists from different countries. India is represented on the Board by Prof. D. G. Karve, President of the Indian Society of Agricultural Economics and Regional Secretary (Asiatic Area) of the International Association of Agricultural Economists. The Society in collaboration with the Directorate of Economics and Statistics in the Ministry of Food and Agriculture, Government of India, has been assisting in the publication of the Journal as a national correspondent ever since its inception in 1958. It is hoped that the Journal will help Agricultural Economists, rural sociologists and research workers in related fields in keeping themselves abreast of most of the literature in their fields published in their own as well as other countries.
