ANNOUNCEMENT OF PRIZE AWARDS FOR 1960

Under the Schemes of Annual Prize Awards instituted by the Society, the first prize under Scheme No. II for best published research papers for the year 1960 will be shared equally by (i) Dr. C. H. Shah, Reader in Agricultural Economics, Department of Economics, University of Bombay, Bombay, for his paper on "Long-term Supply Function and Agricultural Adjustments in a Growing Economy" published in the *Indian Journal of Agricultural Economics*, Vol. XV, No. 2, April-June, 1960, and (ii) Dr. N. A. Mujumdar, Lecturer in Agricultural Economics, Department of Economics, University of Bombay, Bombay for his paper on "Economic Development with Surplus Labour" published in *Indian Economic Journal*, Vol. VII, No. 3, January, 1960. The prize amount was fixed at Rs. 250/- each.

The second prize awarded under Scheme No. II will be shared by (i) Shri S. S. Gill, Department of Economics, Khalsa College, Amritsar, for his paper on "Unemployment and Underemployment of Permanent Farm Workers", published in *Artha Vijnana*, Vol. II, No. 4, December, 1960, and (ii) Shri Dharam Narain, Junior Fellow, Institute of Economic Growth, University of Delhi, Delhi, for his paper on "Impact of Price Movements on Areas under Crops in India—Cotton: A Case Study", published in *Indian Economic Review*, Vol. V, No. 2, August, 1960. The prize amount was fixed at Rs. 125/- each.

No prize award has been made under Scheme No. I for best articles on "Role of Agriculture in Economic Development—A critical resume of India's planning experience in the context of general theory and Indian conditions."

VENUE AND SUBJECTS FOR THE NEXT CONFERENCE OF THE SOCIETY

The 22nd Annual Conference of our Society will be held sometime in the last week of December, 1962 at Ahmedabad (Gujarat), under the auspices of the Gujarat University. The exact dates and the final programme will be communicated in due course.

The following subjects are selected for discussion at the Conference:

1. Economics of Cropping Pattern.
2. Agricultural Development and Co-operative Finance.
3. Levels of Living in Rural Areas (including Tribal Areas).

APPENDIX I

THE INDIAN SOCIETY OF AGRICULTURAL ECONOMICS CONSTITUTION

1. The name of the Society shall be "The Indian Society of Agricultural Economics."
2. The objects of the Society shall be to promote the investigation, study and improvement of the economic and social conditions of agriculture and rural life.

These objects shall be pursued by :—

- (a) holding periodical Conferences for the discussion of problems;
- (b) publishing papers or summaries of papers, either separately or collec-

tively, or in a periodical which may be issued under the auspices of the Society;

- (c) co-operating with other institutions having similar objects, such as the International Association of Agricultural Economists and the Indian Economic Association;
- (d) any other means which the Society may decide.

3. The Society shall consist of (a) Members, (b) Honorary Members, and (c) Member-Institutions, who are interested in the economic and social conditions of agriculture and rural life.

Candidates for Membership shall be nominated by any two Members of the Society and admitted to membership on being approved by the Executive Committee.

Candidates for Honorary Membership shall be nominated by the Executive Committee and elected by a majority of Members present and voting at a General Meeting of the Society.

Institutions wishing to become members shall apply to the Executive Committee and will be admitted to Membership on its approval.

Members and Member-Institutions shall pay to the Society an annual subscription of Rs. 12/-. The composition of subscription for Life-Membership shall be Rs. 250/-.

Member-Institutions shall be entitled to send only one representative to the Conferences and Meetings and shall not be entitled to the composition of subscription for Life-Membership.

4. Except as otherwise provided in the Constitution, the business of the Society shall be conducted by the Executive Committee.

5. The Office-bearers of the Society shall be a President, three Vice-Presidents, an Honorary Secretary-Treasurer and an Honorary Joint-Secretary if appointed.

The Executive Committee of the Society shall consist of :—

- (1) The President,
- (2) three Vice-Presidents,
- (3) an Honorary Secretary-Treasurer,
- (4) an Honorary Joint-Secretary (if appointed), and
- (5) nine Members.

The President and in his absence one of the Vice-Presidents present, shall preside at the Executive Committee Meetings.

The Office-bearers and the Executive Committee shall hold office till their successors are elected.

The Executive Committee shall fill any vacancies in the Committee occurring during their period of office.

6. The General Meetings of the Society shall ordinarily be held once a year. The time and place of such General Meetings shall be fixed by the Executive Committee and not less than twenty-eight days' notice of these General Meetings shall be given to all members, Hon. Members and Member-Institutions.

A Special General Meeting may be convened by the Executive Committee at any time and shall also be convened on the requisition of not less than twenty-five Members. Fourteen days' notice of such Special General Meeting shall be given.

The following business shall be transacted at the General Meetings :—

- (1) Consideration of the annual report and audited accounts.
- (2) Election of Office-bearers and the Executive Committee.
- (3) Election of Hon. Members if any.
- (4) Appointment of auditors.
- (5) Consideration of any proposed amendments to the Constitution, subject to Clause 7.
- (6) Other relevant business.

7. Any amendments intended to effect any alteration in the Constitution of the Society, shall be submitted in the form of a written notice of motion, to be circulated to Members, Hon. Members and Member-Institutions with the notice of a General Meeting and shall be considered at such General Meeting. Amendments shall be carried with two-thirds majority of the Members present at such General Meeting.

The Annual Conference

The 20th Annual Conference of the Society was held at Chandigarh from 21st to 25th December, 1960 under the auspices of the University of Panjab. It was inaugurated by Shri N. V. Gadgil, Governor of Punjab, Punjab. Prof. M. L. Dantwala, Head of the Department of Economics, University of Bombay, presided over the deliberations. The following subjects were discussed:

1. Problems of Marketable Surplus in Indian Agriculture.
2. Economics of Mixed Farming in Different Regions.
3. Distribution of Incomes in the Rural Sector in India.

Some of the papers read and the proceedings of the Conference have been published in the January-March 1961 issue of the Society's Journal.

The Indian Journal of Agricultural Economics

During the year the Society continued with the publication of the Indian Journal of Agricultural Economics and brought out three issues. The fourth issue is scheduled for publication in January 1962.

The International Conference of Agricultural Economists

Prof. D. G. Karve, the President of the Society was appointed as the Regional-Secretary for Asia of the International Conference of Agricultural Economists in 1958. The office work in connection with this assignment was attended to by the office of the Society.

The Eleventh International Conference of Agricultural Economists was held at Cuernavaca, Mexico, between 20th to 30th August, 1961. Prof. D. G. Karve, Dr. S. R. Sen and Shri V. M. Jakhade attended this Conference. Three other delegates, namely, Prof. M. L. Dantwala, Dr. R. N. Poduval and Dr. J. P. Bhattacharjee could not attend due to unavoidable reasons. The subject for discussion at this Conference was 'the role of agriculture in economic development'. A brief report on the proceedings of this Conference will be published in the January-March, 1962 issue of the Society's Journal.

Conference on Agro-Economic Research

The Society participated in the Conference of 'Agro-Economic Research in India', organised by the Directorate of Economics and Statistics in the Ministry of Food and Agriculture, Government of India, on 23rd October, 1961 at New Delhi, with a view to throwing light on the data collected, studies undertaken and the problems faced by various institutions engaged in agro-economic research. Prof. D. G. Karve, President, attended the Conference. Two papers prepared by Dr. C. H. Shah with the help of the Research Staff of the Society on "Agricultural Economics Research—Attempts and Achievements" and "Trends in Study and Research in Problems in Agricultural Economics in India 1940-1961" were submitted to the Conference on behalf of the Society.

Publications

During the year the Society brought out the following three publications :

I. *Co-operation in Karjan* : The Society conducted a Survey of the Co-operative Movement in Karjan Taluka of Baroda District of the Bombay State in 1957. The main object of the survey was to examine critically the progress of Co-operative Movement in the Taluka, to assess its impact on the social and economic life of the people, and to suggest ways and means for accelerating the pace of its progress. The report embodying the findings was published in January, 1961.

II. *Cost Studies in Agriculture* : The Society organised a Research Seminar on 'Problems of Cost Studies in Agriculture' in collaboration with the Ministry of Food and Agriculture, Government of India and the Indian Society of Agricultural Statistics, from 28th October to 5th November, 1960. The report containing the papers presented and the proceedings at the Seminar was published in May, 1961.

III. *Rural Sociology in India* : In 1953 the Society published a book entitled 'Rural Sociology in India' by Dr. A. R. Desai. The second edition of this book was published in 1959. As this edition was sold out, a third edition was brought out during the year. This opportunity was utilized for revision of certain parts and incorporating some additional material.

I. *Research Schemes and Surveys*

Besides the schemes included in last year's report the following projects are under consideration for research:

(i) Evaluation of the Progress of Co-operative Marketing in a few selected areas;

(ii) Critical Appraisal of the Working of some selected Processing Co-operatives;

(iii) Evaluation of the Working of the Scheme for Development of Warehousing and Storage;

- (iv) Study of the working and performance of the Panchayati Raj;
- (v) Pilot study on the flow of funds between the rural and urban areas;
- (vi) Intensive study of the Administration of Co-operatives at the District level.

II. *Co-operatives in Yugoslav Agriculture*: The Research Programmes Committee of the Society has approved the publication of a research study on "Co-operatives in Yugoslav Agriculture", prepared by Shri Samar Pal Singh (of Nainital) at the University of Belgrade. The Press copy is getting ready and the publication will be brought out in early 1962.

III. *Studies in Indian Agricultural Economics*: On the occasion of the Tenth International Conference of Agricultural Economists held at Mysore in August, 1958 the Society published a Volume entitled 'Studies in Indian Agricultural Economics'. As the first edition has been sold out and as the demand for it is good it has been decided to bring out a revised edition of it. The authors who contributed articles have been requested to bring their articles upto date. It is expected that the revised edition will be published in 1962.

IV. *World Agricultural Economics and Rural Sociology Abstracts*: The Society has undertaken the work of preparing brief summaries of books and articles published in India, covering agricultural economics in its broadest sense including rural sociology, on behalf of the above quarterly Journal published by the International Association of Agricultural Librarians and Documentalists in co-operation with the International Association of Agricultural Economists. Accordingly the abstracts are being sent to the Editorial Office of the Association every quarter. During the year, these abstracts were despatched three times according to the requirements of the Editorial Office.

Seminars

It is proposed to convene a Research Seminar in May 1962. The subject for the Seminar is under consideration and would be announced later.

Library

Members are aware that the Society has a fairly well-equipped Research-Reference-Lending Library. During the year nearly 800 books, including pamphlets, reports and bound periodicals, were added bringing the total number of books to 5,400. The Library receives 175 periodicals in Agricultural Economics and allied subjects. Quite a few Journals from foreign countries are received in exchange of our Journal. Efforts are being made to increase the number of periodicals received.

During the year the Library undertook a new line of activity, *viz.*, 'an index of important articles on agricultural economics'. This is prepared every quarter since January, 1961. Important articles on agricultural economics from 80 periodicals are being indexed and classified according to subject. Copies of this index are supplied to members as also research workers on request. Many members as well as non-members have found this service helpful. Three quarterly lists are already brought out.

Apart from serving as a clearing house of information, the library provides useful reference facilities to many Government and Semi-government institutions, students and staff members of the Bombay University and a few city colleges.

Prize Awards

With a view to encouraging students of Agricultural Economics and promoting contribution of literature on the subject, the Society has instituted two schemes of annual Prize Awards. Under Scheme No. I two prizes of Rs. 500/- and Rs. 250/- and under Scheme No. II two prizes of Rs. 500/- and Rs. 250/- are awarded for best research contributions and published research in Agricultural Economics respectively.

The following prizes will be awarded for the year 1960:

- (i) Two Prizes under Scheme No. I for the best research articles on "Role of Agriculture in Economic Development—A critical resume of India's planning experience in the context of general theory and Indian conditions."
- (ii) Two prizes under Scheme No. II for the best paper of published research in Agricultural Economics in the year 1960.

Membership

The year 1961 opened with a membership of 449. During the year 65 new members were enrolled and 62 ceased to be members. The number of members thus stand at 452 at the close of the year. The Society has 45 Donor Members, 12 Honorary Members, 20 Life Members and 452 ordinary members, bringing the grand total to the figure of 529.

Accounts

The Society is grateful to the Government of India, for renewing their usual grant of Rs. 50,000 for the year 1961-62. The Balance Sheet and Income & Expenditure Account for the year 1960-61 has been published in July-September, 1961 issue of the Journal.

We take this opportunity of conveying our grateful thanks to Messrs. Dalal & Shah, Auditors and Accountants, Bombay, who were good enough to act as Honorary Auditors to our institution for the current year.

It is a matter of satisfaction that the Society has been able to carry out its various activities with the valuable help of honorary workers whose active co-operation has always been an asset to this institution. The Society takes this opportunity of conveying sincere thanks to the members of the Executive Committee, Members of the Editorial Board of the Journal, Members of the Research Programmes Committee, and to all other members of the Society who have rendered valuable services during the year.

We take this opportunity of placing on record the work of the members of the staff who have co-operated whole-heartedly and have discharged their duties efficiently.
