Agricultural University, Rajendranagar, Hyderabad (A.P.) from 26th to 28th December, 1973. The subjects selected for discussion at this Session of the Conference are:

- (1) Integrated Area Development with reference to District Planning.
- (2) Agricultural Input Supply Systems including Marketing.
- (3) Benefit-Cost Analysis of Agricultural Projects
