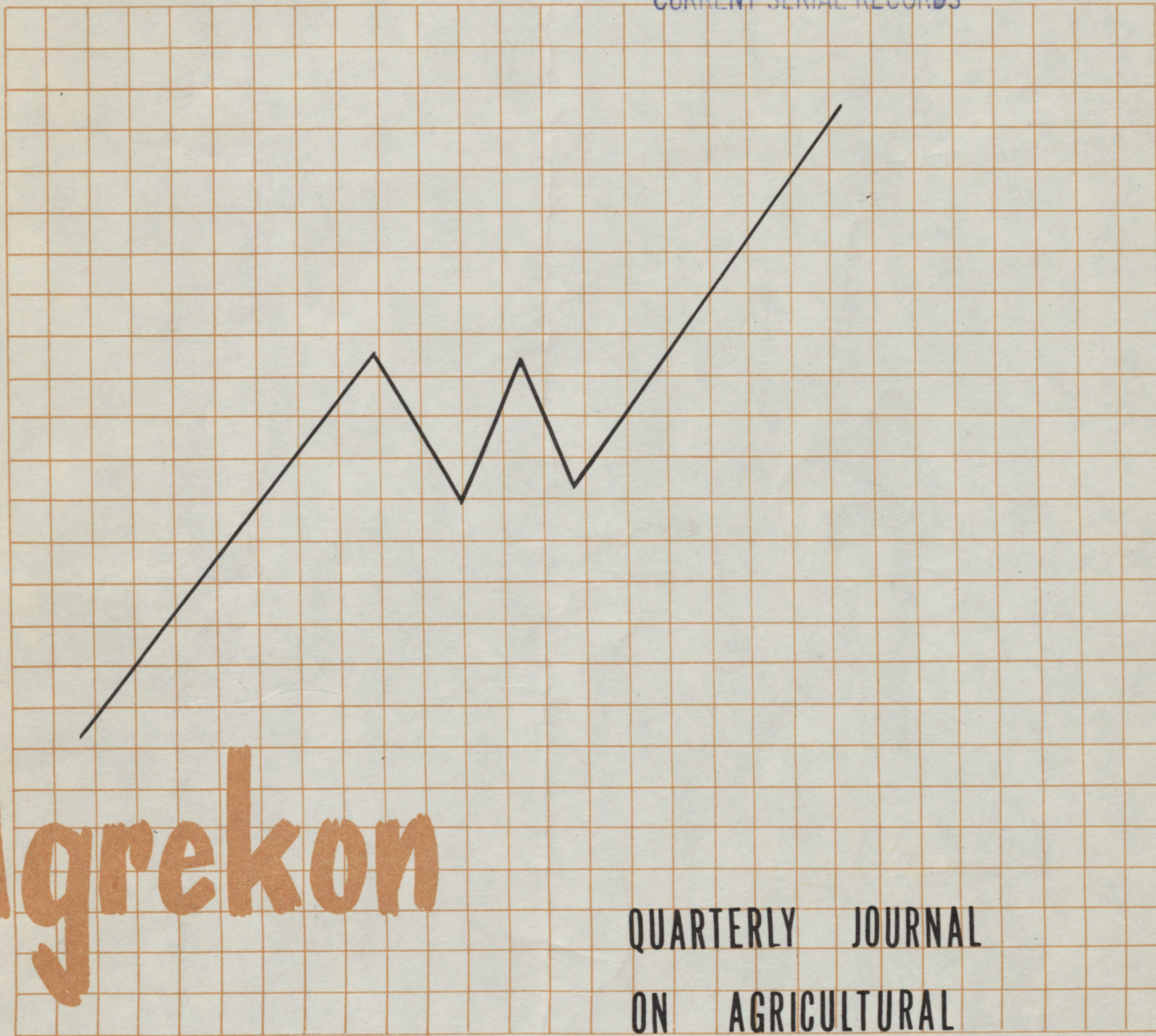

S.J.J. DE SWARDT-AGREKON PRIZE

The S.J.J. de Swardt Agrekon Prize for 1976 has been awarded to Mr M.D. Nel of Perdekop Meule, Perdekop, and Prof. J.A. Groenewald of the University of Pretoria for their article "Optimal production scheduling in pig production" which appeared in the October 1976 issue of Agrekon.

It is the fifth time that this award has been made since Mr S.J.J. de Swardt, former Secretary for Agricultural Economics and Marketing, made a donation to the Department of Agricultural Economics and Marketing in 1973 for the purpose of establishing a fund from which to award prizes for meritorious contributions in the field of Agricultural Economics that have appeared in Agrekon.
