Hy was die eerste Ere-President van LEVSA en die volgende woorde sê iets meer van die mens agter die prys.

SJJ de SWARDT/AGREKON PRIZE

This is an annual prize awarded for the best published article in Agrekon. This prestige prize is announced and awarded at the annual conference of the Agricultural Economics Association of Southern Africa. The prize was made possible by the forming of a trust by Mr SJJ de Swardt, a honorary member of AEASA. Mr de Swardt, now retired after a long career in service of agriculture, lives in Pretoria and continues to be an active member of the association. He was the first Honorary President of the AEASA. To reveal more of the man behind the prize, we quote -

Take an interest in what is happening on the broader front in South Africa as a whole and also in the wider world. Maintain thus an alert spirit and promote a fruitful and happy life."
