This Conference Number of the Journal contains the Papers submitted for discussion at the 28th Annual Conference of the Society scheduled to be held under the auspices of the Agricultural College and Research Institute at Coimbatore from 23rd to 25th December, 1968. The subjects selected for discussion at the Conference are :

1. Institutional Finance for Agricultural Development.
2. Economic Aspects of High-Yielding Varieties Programme.
3. International Trade in Agricultural Commodities with particular reference to Primary Producing Countries.
4. Development of Fisheries—Economic Aspects.

This number also includes the Rapporteurs' Reports on each of these four subjects. It is heartening to note that a large number of Papers has been received on the first two subjects. The President of the Conference on the recommendation of the Rapporteurs has accepted a record number of 84 Papers for discussion at this Conference. Out of these, 31 Papers have been published in full in this number along with summaries of 53 Papers. We regret that it has not been possible to reproduce all the Papers in full because of the heavy cost of printing and the limited financial resources of the Society. We apologise to the authors whose Papers could not be printed in full. We are grateful to the Rapporteurs for sending their Reports within a very short time, covering the important points contained in the Papers and highlighting the issues for discussion.
