ANNOUNCEMENT

WORKSHOP ON AGRICULTURAL ECONOMICS RESEARCH

The Indian Society of Agricultural Economics proposes to organise the third Workshop on Agricultural Economics Research in Northern India in collaboration with the Institute of Agricultural Sciences, Banaras Hindu University at Varanasi (Uttar Pradesh) from 4th to 7th October, 1986. The main aim of the Workshop is to upgrade the research competence of the researchers and teachers in Agricultural Economics and to improve their technical competence for teaching. The research areas proposed to be covered in the workshop include (a) Application of statistical methods to study income distribution, price analysis, marketing margins, consumption pattern/behaviour, yield gaps in agriculture, agricultural wages. etc.; (b) Correct use of production function, regression analysis, linear programming. mathematical programming techniques; (c) Measuring growth rates in agriculture and (d) Price determination, procurement price, public distribution system, price controls, and prices and production. The discussions will cover briefly the methodology adopted for research in the selected research area and sources of data and limitations of available data base; but the main thrust will be to explain ways of avoiding some of the common weaknesses observed in a few selected case studies of papers received by the Editorial Board. The participation in this Workshop will be confined to the Society's members who had submitted research papers to the Journal from the northern region. The Workshop will be conducted by a panel of experts.
