D.K. Desai Prize Award for the Best Article Published in the Indian Journal of Agricultural Economics in 1989

Under the D.K. Desai Prize Awards Scheme instituted by the Indian Society of Agricultural Economics, eight articles published in the three regular issues of the Indian Journal of Agricultural Economics during the year 1989 were considered for prize by the Prize Awards Committee. On the recommendation of the Prize Awards Committee, the Society awarded the prize of Rs. 1,000 to the best article on "Agriculture and Industry: A Study of Selected Linkages" authored by Professor D.M. Nachane, Dr. (Ms) S.D. Sawant and Dr. C.V. Achuthan, Department of Economics, University of Bombay, Bombay. The article was published in the April-June 1989 issue of the Indian Journal of Agricultural Economics.

There was no article among the group of articles considered for the prize, contributed by author(s) with basic degree in Agricultural Sciences, and hence no prize was awarded under this category.

Subjects Selected for Discussion at the Next (51st) Annual Conference of the Society

The 51st Annual Conference of the Indian Society of Agricultural Economics will be held under the auspices of Andhra Pradesh Agricultural University at Rajendranagar, Hyderabad-500 030 (A.P.) sometime in December 1991. The following three subjects have been selected for discussion at the Conference:

- 1. Farming Systems in the Post-Green Revolution Belt.
- 2. Watershed Development.
- Land and Water Markets.

The Indicative Outlines of these subjects have been circulated to the members and member-institutions. Research Papers not exceeding 10 pages each (typed in double space on one side only) including tables, annexures, references, etc., along with their Summaries (not exceeding 200 words) in *triplicate* are invited for discussion at the Conference and should reach the Society's Office not later than 1st July, 1991.
