High morbidity

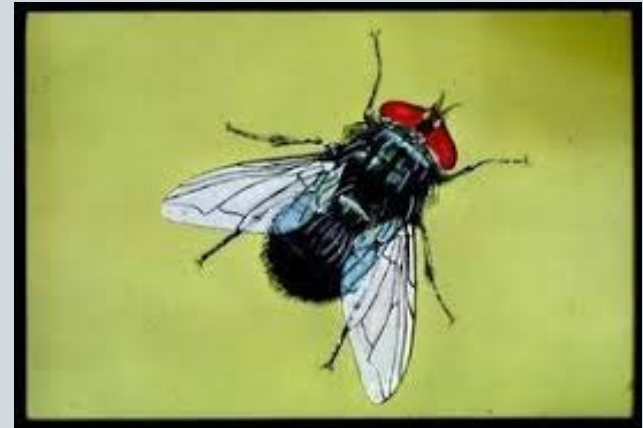

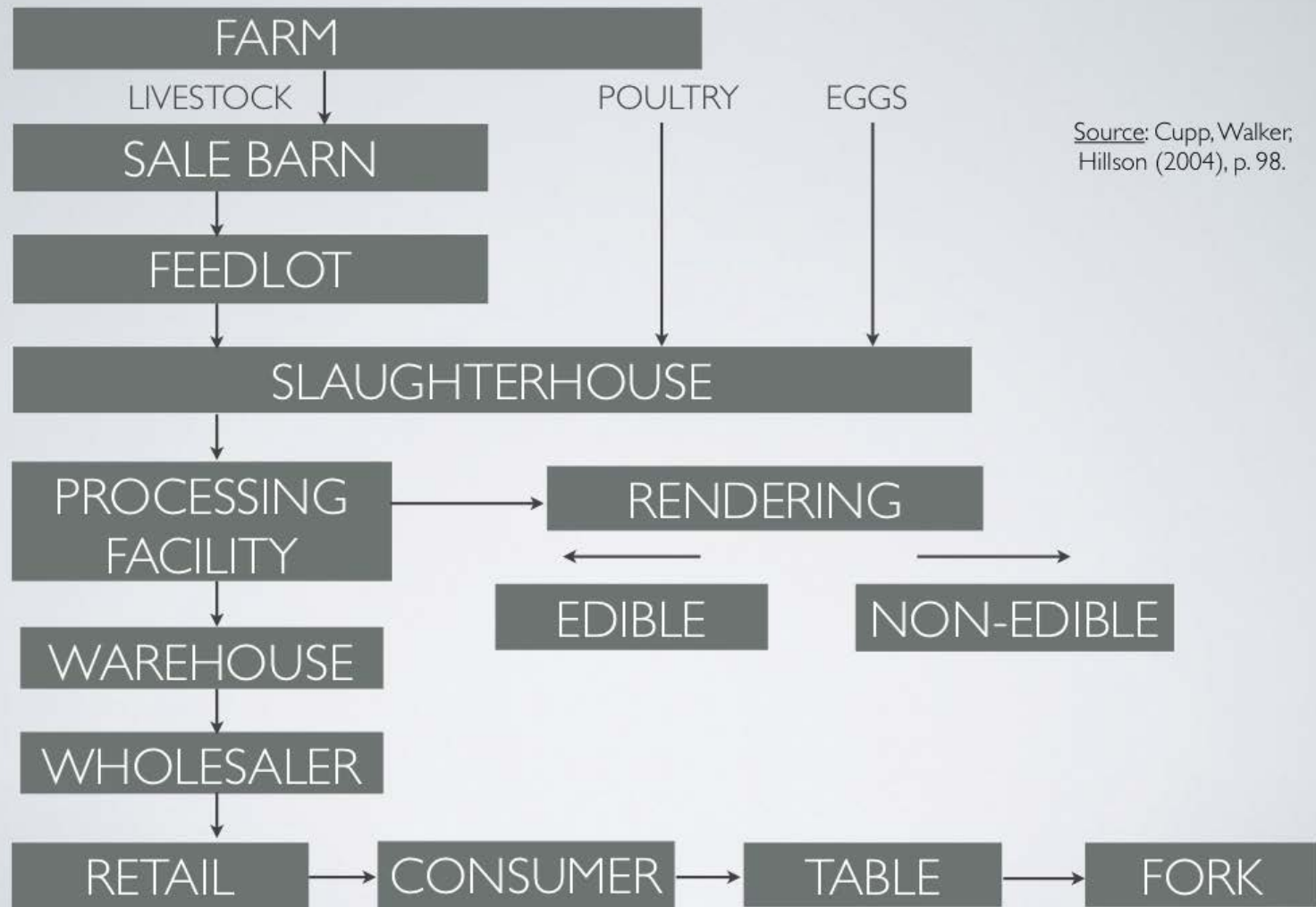
