- Statement of Problem (a short paragraph)
- Objectives
- Methodology (major points only)
- Results and Conclusions
- Implications (pertinent to the food industry)

The paper should be double spaced (including tables, charts, references, etc.). Tables and charts should be numbered consecutively throughout the text and should follow the first reference to the table. Omit color visuals; we are not in a position to use them at this time. The Society has a page charge of \$35 per page and it also requires that at least one author of an accepted paper must be a member of the Society. Send two copies of your paper to the Vice President for Publication.
