## GUIDELINES FOR MANUSCRIPT SUBMISSION

**Eligibility:** Open to all individuals although page charges vary by membership.

**Cover Letter:** Indicate whether the manuscript, or a version of it, has been published or considered for publication elsewhere.

**Submission:** Send four copies of the manuscript to:

**Title Page:** On the title page, include the article title, full names, and titles of authors, academic or other professional affiliations, and complete address of the author to whom correspondence should be sent.

**Abstract:** Includes the title and an abstract of about 100 words. The authors' identification should not be repeated in the abstract or on other pages of the manuscript.

**Manuscript:** The manuscript should be typed double-spaced on one side of 8½" x 11" paper. Allow margins of at least one inch on all sides of the typed pages. Number manuscript pages consecutively throughout the paper.

**Tables and Figures:** All tables and figures must be discussed or mentioned in the text and numbered consecutively in order of mention. Each table and figure should have a brief descriptive title.

**References:** In-text citations should be cited by author(s) followed by the date in parentheses. All references should be placed in alphabetical order at the end of the paper with the heading "References." Use the same format used in previous issues of the *JFDR*.

**Review:** All submitted manuscripts will be refereed by the editorial board and others selected for their professional competence.

**Page Charges:** A page charge is billed to the authors' supporting institution or granting agency after the article is accepted for publication. Proceedings Issue (No. 1): Page charges are \$25 per page for research reports (no charge for invited papers and research updates). Refereed Issues: \$45 per page for members, \$50 per page for non-members. For the refereed issues, one author receives 30 reprints.
