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U.S.-State Agricultural Data

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ABSTRACT

This report presents agricultural information for each of the 50 States and the United States. Included are data on population, land use, agricultural production, farm income, value of assets on farms, and selected characteristics of farms such as size, tenure, and farm organization.

The primary data sources are the 1982 Census of Agriculture, and the 1983 Economic Indicators of the Farm Sector, published by the Economic Research Service. Unless otherwise stated, data are for 1982.

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NOTES AND REFERENCES

The information has been grouped into 21 sections. Each note provides further explanation.

Section I

Population figures are based on a final estimate from the 1980 Census.

Section IV

Agricultural universities are those colleges and universities established under the 1862 and 1890 Morrill Acts.

Section V

The figure for percentage of farmers with nonfarm occupation represents farmers spending more than 50 percent of their worktime in 1982 in occupations other than farming or ranching. The remainder are farmers spending 50 percent or more of their worktime in farming or ranching. Percentage of farmers with nonfarm income represents farmers who, on the 1979 Farm Finance Survey, indicated that they earned income from a source other than farming or ranching. This survey is a follow up of the 1978 Census of Agriculture. More current figures are not available because they were not collected in the 1982 Census.

Sections VIII and IX

Data on the production of major commodities are taken from the 1983 Economic Indicators of the Farm Sector published by the Economic Research Service. Commodities specified in Area IX are the top five export commodities for the United States. Data on cash receipts are that State's receipts for those commodities.

Sections XVII, XVIII, and XIX

1984 figures are based on preliminary data.

Section XX

The location of each county seat was obtained from the 1981 World Almanac and Book of Facts.

Section XXI

Additional information about a State's agriculture can be obtained from that State's statistical office. See the U.S. data sheet for Federal agencies to contact concerning data on U.S. agriculture.






