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Background

The first Survey of Annual Outlook Information was conducted by the AAEA in 1978, under the direction of an outlook task force that was formed by the AAEA Agricultural Statistics Committee. Survey forms were mailed to all AAEA members in early June 1978 and a follow up mailing was made in mid-July to Agricultural Economics Heads and selected businesses which provide analytical services. Department Heads were encouraged to have persons on their staff with responsibility for outlook to respond to the survey.

There were 53 responses to the survey questionnaire in 1978, including 36 university economists, 11 from industry and business and 6 from government agencies. Responses to the 1978 survey were summarized by John Ikerd of Oklahoma State University and presented at the first annual AAEA Outlook Survey session at the summer meetings in Blacksburg, Virginia.

Mean values of the responses (forecasts) were presented as well as the standard deviation of responses, the minimum and maximum responses, and the coefficient of variation for each value. Responses concerning 1979 data were also tabulated by affiliation (university, industry/busines, government), by the extent to which formal models were used in the forecasts, and by the extent of respondent responsibility for outlook analysis.

A comparison of mean values for 1978 data and actual 1978 outcomes is presented in table 1. In general, the percentage error on livestock and poultry data estimates was smaller than on crop related data estimates. The average error on 10 livestock and poultry data estimates was 1.8%, with a range of .5% to 4.1% on individual items.

On crop related data estimates, the average error on twenty items was 6.3%, with a range of .1% to 17.4% on individual data estimates. Soybean forecasts were the most accurate, with an average error of 2.8% on 6 different items and a range of 1.2% to 4.3%.

Table 2 summarizes the mean values of the 1979 forecasts for the various data series. The mean values of responses from all survey participants are presented in the first data column. Mean values of forecasts for several different respondent classifications are also presented.

The relative accuracy of these forecasts cannot be measured until the actual 1979 data is available. However, two sets of data are presented for comparisons with the various forecasts. Actual values for either the marketing or calendar year to date are shown in the next to last column. The last column in table 2 presents current forecasts from USDA sources of the various economics data.

In general, actual prices so far this year on most livestock poultry and crop items have averaged above the forecast levels. Forecasts of cash receipts, net farm income and price inflation, however, appear to be low in relation to likely actual performance.
