In accordance with Sections 2272 and 2279 of the California Food and Agricultural Code, I am pleased to present the 2013 Del Norte County Crop Report.

All values in this report are the gross value of crops and commodities and do not reflect production, harvesting, marketing or transportation costs.

Overall production for 2013 was valued at 44,397,031. This represents an increase of 6.1%. Increased milk, livestock and timber production was responsible for the gain.


In accordance with Sections 2272 and 2279 of the California Food and Agricultural Code, I am pleased to present the 2015 Del Norte County Crop Report.
