INTRODUCTION

This bibliography lists home gardening and home processing publications published by the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Cooperative Extension Services, and Agricultural Experiment Stations from 1965 to 1975. References have been compiled from lists of publications received from various land grant institutions and from The National Bibliography of Agriculture. This report is a companion publication to the Bibliography on the Economics of Fruit and Vegetable Production and Marketing, 1965-76, AGERS-38, to be published shortly by the Economic Research Service.

This bibliography contains references to culture, gardening, canning, freezing, and drying of fruits and vegetables and will be of use mainly to those who advise home gardeners and homemakers. References are listed alphabetically by author for fruits, vegetables, and fruits and vegetables combined under the two major subjects, gardening and processing. Berries are listed with fruits, and melons with vegetables. An alphabetical listing of authors, with numbered references, is included.

These listings are believed to be currently available from the sources cited. Copies of the reports or information regarding U.S. Department of Agriculture publications may be obtained from Public Services, Agricultural Research Service, Rm. 347, Federal Building, Hyattsville, Maryland 20782. Other publications may be obtained from the publishing institutions, whose current addresses are listed at the end of this report.
