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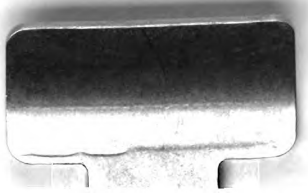
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FROM THE EDITORS

Volume XXIX of the *Journal of the Transportation Research Forum* is completed with the publication of this second issue. It contains the balance of papers which were accepted for publication. Earlier versions of these papers were presented at the 1988 TRF Annual Meeting and Forum in Toronto, Canada. In addition, four papers receiving an award or honorable mention at the 1988 CTRF Annual Meeting, TRF's award winning student papers, and three book reviews are included. Finally, an authors' index for the entire volume appears at the end of this issue.

The two issue volume has been a great success from the standpoint of facilitating a more thorough review process. We have been able to work with authors to an extent not possible with one issue per year. The quality of the articles published in this issue is a reflection of this more intense review process.

In the first issue of this volume, we asked for comments from readers and attendees at the TRF Annual Forum. To date, we have received none. This is our one disappointment with how the JTRF is evolving. For the benefit of the entire TRF membership, the transportation profession in general and in the interests of promoting a dialogue on important transportation issues of the day, SEND US A COMMENT.
