



Figure 1. Comparison of Prices Recieved by Hog Producers in the U.S. and Mexico








US BEEF EXPORTS TO JAPAN

- Included in Farm Bill
- "Born, Raised & Slaughtered
- **Costs**
 - USDA Record Keeping
 - •\$1.9 Billion
 - \$1.0 Billion for Producers




Country of Origin Labeling (COOL)

- Costs
 - Full Traceback System for Pork
 - \$10.22 per Head
 - •\$1.0 Billion
 - Certification with Audit
 - Less Expensive
 - Devastating to Exports
 - 50% Lower by 2010

Environment - CAFO Rule

- Raises the "Environmental Bar"
- ◆1000 Animal Units
- Applies to 15,500 Livestock Operations
 - Up from 4,500
 - 11,000 Required to Apply by 2006
- New Requirements



Environment - Air Quality

- NAS Study
 - Requested by EPA & USDA
 - Need for Science-Based Methods
- Recommendations
 - Develop methods for:
 - Measuring
 - Determining Spread
