Bridging Critical Gaps: Enhanced Funding for Avian Influenza

- To date, Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (H5N1) has not been detected in North America.
- Enhanced efforts within the U.S. are designed to prevent and prepare for an outbreak.
- President's FY07 budget request is \$82 million
