The Arab Organization for Agricultural Development (AOAD) was established in 1972 within the framework of the League of Arab States as a specialized agency. The major objectives were: to develop natural and human resources, upgrade agricultural productivity, secure facility of exchange of agricultural products among member countries, help to boost agricultural production and achieve self sufficiency. AOAD thus adopted the necessary means to realize its objectives, particularly the compilation and publication of data and information related to agriculture and food, and support and coordination of local and regional efforts in respect to research and social studies, promotion of agricultural training, extension, and rural community development, conservation of natural resources, adoption of improved agricultural production methods, improvement of food and agricultural products, process marketing and the promotion of agro-industries, provide necessary technical assistance and exchange of expertise in the field of agriculture. AOAD also follows up international achievement and cooperates with other local, regional and international organizations.

The International Service for National Agricultural Research (ISNAR) began operating at its headquarters in The Hague, Netherlands on September 1, 1980. It was established by the Consultative Group on International Agricultural Research (CGIAR), on the basis of recommendations from an international task force, for the purpose of assisting governments of developing countries to strengthen their agricultural research. It is a non-profit autonomous agency, international in character, and non-political in management, staffing, and operations.

Of the 13 centers in the CGIAR network, ISNAR is the only one that focuses primarily on national agricultural research issues. It provides advice to governments, upon request, on research policy, organization, and management issues, thus complementing the activities of other assistance agencies.

ISNAR has active advisory service, research, and training programs.

ISNAR is supported by a number of the members of CGIAR, an informal group of approximately 43 donors, including countries, development banks, international organizations, and foundations.




