Please follow "Guidelines for Submitting Manuscripts." Manuscripts will be accepted at any time. Deadline for submitting manuscripts for the next issue is October 2, 1989, but early submission is encouraged to ensure consideration for the issue. Articles published will be subject to a page charge of \$40 per printed page. Authors without financial support from an employer may petition for an exemption.

The eight articles in this issue were selected from fourteen manuscripts reviewed for publication.

## A Message from the Publisher


