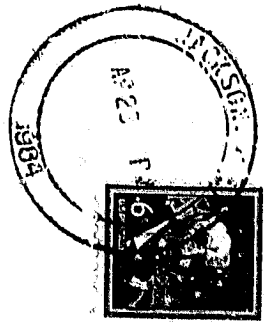

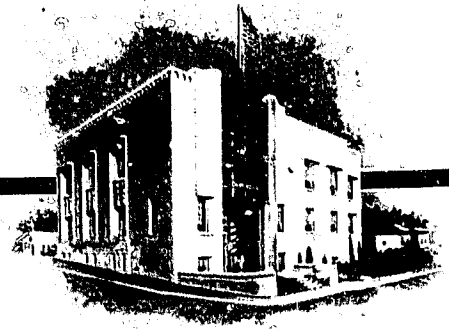

AMADOR COUNTY
GENERAL INFORMATION

Amador County is located on the eastern slope of the Sacramento Valley in the Sierra Nevada foothills. It ranges from an elevation of 200 feet at Ione to 8500 feet at the Kit Carson Pass on Highway 88. Its rolling hills are primarily used for the production of lumber and cattle. Shenandoah Valley produces much of the sheep, grapes and wine, fruit and nut crops, and some field crops. The balance of the field crops and nearly all of the milk are produced in the Ione and Jackson Valley areas. Amador County is also the center of the Angora goat raising industry. From these goats come the mohair.

Amador County abounds with recreational facilities. Pardee Reservoir Recreation Area is located near Ione. Also located in the southwest portion of the county is the Camanche Dam Recreational Area, a three county facility. To be completed in 1965, the thirty-three million dollar 155 foot high earth-filled dam will be one of California's finest recreation areas with swimming, boating, water skiing, fishing, camp facilities, et cetera. There are also Bear River and Silver Lake, both on Highway 88, for the camper, boater and fisherman. The hunting and fishing in the back country are excellent. For the winter sport enthusiast, Amador County rates high in the California picture.

The livelihood of the county from the standpoint of employment is derived from the following classifications of work: public work (Federal, State and County), lumbering, agriculture, hydro-electric power, manufacturing, mining and small businesses. In addition, there are the famed clay, silica sand and lignite deposits located in the Ione area. There are only two lignite deposits bearing Montan Wax in the world, the Ione plant and a plant in East Germany.

Livestock production again leads in total value. Sheep and lambs show a reduction but this is made up by an increase in livestock production and the increased production of dairy replacement stock.

Field crops show an increase in 1966. This was possible by the beginning of production of a portion of the new Jackson Valley Irrigation District.

Fruit and nut crop remain about the same with new acres of walnuts coming into production to off-set lower yields in the wine grapes.

1966 was a record year for Amador County agriculture.

It is my pleasure to submit the 1969 Agricultural Crop Report for Amador County in accordance with Section 2279 of the California Agriculture Code.

1969 was once again a record agricultural value year for Amador County. Livestock production again leads in total values, showing a general increase in all classes. This was brought about by a good feed year and a substantial increase in prices.

Field crops also show an increase in crop value in 1969. The increase was caused by switching to higher value crops, a better price structure, and a slight increase in irrigated acreage.

The only decrease in the crop report was in fruit and nut crops, and this was caused by a very short prune crop and substantial reduction in prices for a slightly larger crop of walnuts.

The values in this crop report are only gross values and in no way tend to show a net return to farmers and ranchers in Amador County. To figure a net return, such things as cost of labor, transportation, production, harvesting, taxes, etc. would have to be deducted.

I wish to thank the many farmers, ranchers and other individuals, as well as the members of my staff for their cooperation and help in compiling this report.

It is my pleasure to submit the 1971 Agricultural Crop Report for Amador County in accordance with Section 2279 of the California Agricultural Code.

The values in this report represent the gross values of commercial agricultural production in Amador County. On this basis the total value of farm production in the County amounted to \$6,751,800 for 1971 as compared to the revised figure of \$6,607,250 for 1970.

The tabulations enclosed indicate increased acreage under irrigation as well as a substantially greater value established for wine grape production.

Although the gross income indicated by this report is a new record, it is not a reflection of increased grower profit. Production and marketing costs have continued to rise, limiting net incomes.

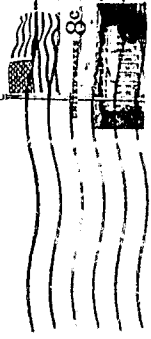

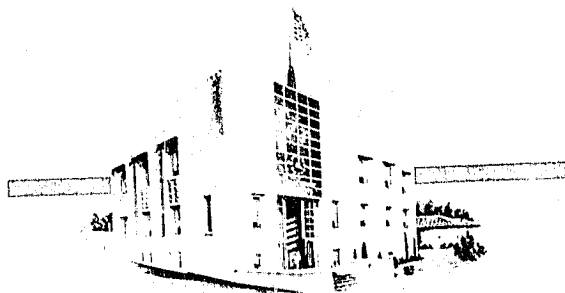
