# Results of the 2008 Farm & Ranch Irrigation Survey (FRIS)





### Census Irrigation History

- Irrigation included in census since 1890
- Special Irrigation Census in 1900
- Special surveys in 1954 and 1959
- FRIS since 1979
- Responsibility shifted to NASS in 1997





### FRIS Data

- The FRIS publication is divided into two Chapters
- Chapter 1 = General FRIS Data Released November 30, 2009
- Chapter 2 = Horticultural Operations FRIS Data

Released February 11, 2010 and appended to the November publication





### FRIS Data

- Data based on samples
- U.S. data more precise than state or water resources areas
- Data levels vary due to weather and economics





### FRIS Sampling Approach

- Selected from farms irrigating in the previous year's census
- Research and institutional farms excluded
- Farms with horticultural sales excluded from general FRIS sample. Those farms were sampled separately and received a horticultural version of the FRIS report form. Data tables are in Chapter 2.





### New FRIS Questions in 2008

- Area irrigated with recycled water
- Area irrigated with reclaimed water
- Reclaimed water purchased
