Guide to Contributors

Language. since the Journal is published in English, material submitted in English will be preferred. However, in certain cases the Editorial Committee may consider manuscripts submitted in other major European languages. Translations of papers previously published in languages other than English can be considered, yet information about that should be provided by the author at the time of submission.

Length and typing. Papers should normally not exceed 5,000 words, double-spaced, on one side of the page only, and bear an inch margin on both sides.

Submission. Articles should be submitted in three copies + diskette, possibly in Word format.

Abstracts. Each paper should be accompanied by a 100-150 word abstract.

First page. The first page of the manuscript should contain the name of the article in capital letters (information about the article should be footnote 1), the name of the author with information pertaining to his/her organization and location.

Footnotes. Authors are requested to use footnotes only when necessary to explain material which is not justified in the text or tables. Footnotes should be numbered consecutively, typed single-spaced and put at the bottom of page.

References. References in the text should be cited by bringing the last name of the author, publication year and page number(s), where appropriate, all within parentheses, for instance: (Fauquet, 1951) or (Fauquet, 1951:42). Subsequent citations of the same source should be brought as in the first instance. If an author has two citations in the same year, these should be distinguished by means of "a" or "b" attached to the name, for instance (Fauquet, 1951a). If publication dates are the same, order them alphabetically by names of titles. For co-authorship, cite both last names of authors. For more than two authors, put *et al.* after the first author's name.

All references cited in the text should be listed alphabetically on separate sheets to be attached to the following style:

- **For books:** Kanter, R.M. (1972). *Commitment and Community: Communes and Utopias in Sociological Perspective*. Cambridge: Harvard University Press.
- **For articles in journals:** Gil, E. (1996). "The individual within the collective: a new perspective". *Journal of Rural Cooperation*, 24:5-16.
- **For articles in books:** Kanter, R.M. (1979). "Communes in Cities" in Case, J. and Taylor, R.C.R. (eds.) *Communes and Collectives: Experiments in Social Change in the 1960s and 1970s*. New York: Pantheon Books, pp. 112-135.

Diagrams, Statistical Tables, and Mathematical Notations. Camera-ready-copies of diagrams and statistical tables should be placed on separate sheets and numbered consecutively. Clear indication should be given in the body of the text as to where the table or diagram has to be placed. Mathematical notations should be given in simple and bold symbols in separate lines.
