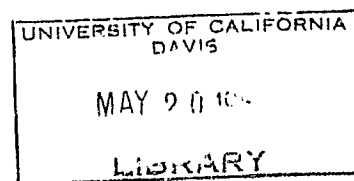

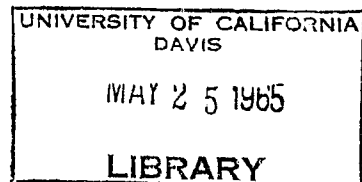

This is the twentieth annual crop report and the values given herein show an average gross return to the farmers and ranchers of Lassen County for their commodities. Field crops showed a gain of about one-half million dollars, while apiary products were up fifty percent which can be attributed to greater yields due to heavy rain fall. Seed garlic showed a better yield and greater price this year while livestock took a drop of about one million dollars. The livestock drop was due to lower prices and less weight in sales.

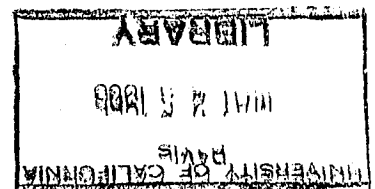

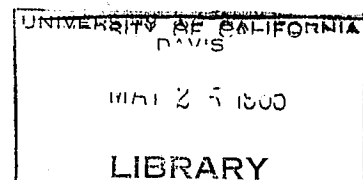

Gentlemen:

In accordance with the provisions of Section 65.5 Agricultural Code, I am pleased to submit the 1965 annual crop report for Lassen County.

The total gross production value for all crops including livestock is \$9,360,738. This represents an increase of \$702,421 over the year 1964. This increase is due primarily to a more favorable livestock market which provided value increases.

While field crops varied somewhat in acreage, yield and values the overall total value remained about the same.

The decrease in total value of seed, vegetable and nursery crops is due primarily to a very unfavorable garlic seed market. This will greatly effect the future production of this crop in Lassen County.

The value figures in this report represent gross value of production. They do not represent net farm income, as production costs are not considered.

I wish to express my sincere appreciation to all individuals and organizations who cooperated so willingly with me and my staff in contributing the necessary information to make this report possible.

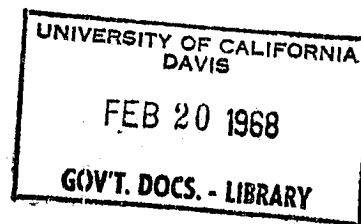

Gentlemen:

in accordance with the provisions of Section 65.5 of the Agricultural Code of the State of California, I herewith submit the 1966 Agricultural Crop Report for the County of Lassen.

The total gross production value, including livestock, is \$9,512,350. This represents an increase over the previous year of \$152,512. While this increase is relatively small, I feel it is significant in view of the fact the lack of rainfall lowered the yield of field crops considerably and despite increased prices, their total production value is down \$329,400.

Livestock and poultry production, the major source of agricultural income in this county, increased \$345,334. This alone more than offset the total value loss of field crops. Because livestock production is such an important part of our economy, inventory figures have been included in this report.

The slight increase in the total value of livestock and poultry products was contributed to largely by an increase in market milk production.


A 52 percent reduction in honey production is responsible for the loss in total value of apiary products. This too is a result of inadequate moisture during the growing season.

The total value of seed, vegetable and nursery crops increased \$114,000. This was a result of increased potato acreage and production. As predicated in 1965, the garlic seed production has declined drastically and is now included in miscellaneous crops.

Again I wish to emphasize, the gross value figures in this report do not represent farm income, as production costs are not considered.

My sincere thanks is extended to the many agencies and individuals for their fine cooperation in making available the necessary data from which this report is compiled.

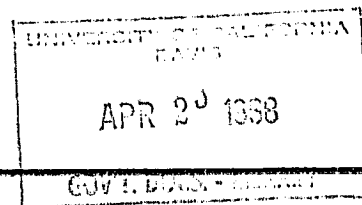

In accordance with the provisions of Section 2279 of the California Agricultural Code, I herewith submit the 1967 Agricultural Crop Report for the County of Lassen.

Agricultural production, this county's leading industry, reached an all time high in 1967 with a total production value of \$10,466,630. This represents an increase of \$958,980 over the previous year.

Field crop production with a total value of \$4,440,900 is running a very close second to livestock production, which is still the leading source of agricultural income. Increased yields due to better growing conditions contributed largely to this \$1,109,700 increase.


Livestock and poultry production, with a total value of \$4,983,330 decreased \$521,770 from the previous year. This decrease as well as the decrease in the value of livestock and poultry products is due largely to the reduction of cattle inventories.

The significant increase in the total value of Seed, Fruit, Vegetable and Nursery Crops is due primarily to increased row crop acreage, and the addition of Christmas tree production, which is now becoming a managed crop and is therefore included in this report.

The value figures in this report represent gross production value, whether sold or used on the farm where produced and therefore do not represent net incomes.

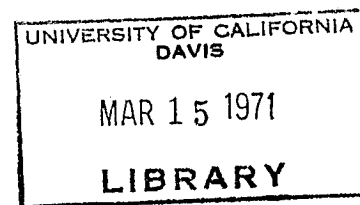


This decrease in production value is attributed largely to a continued reduction in the value of livestock and poultry production. Although unit values were generally higher, they failed to offset the decrease in production.


It is with great pleasure that I submit the 1973 Lassen County Crop Report as prescribed by Section 2279 of the California Agricultural Code.

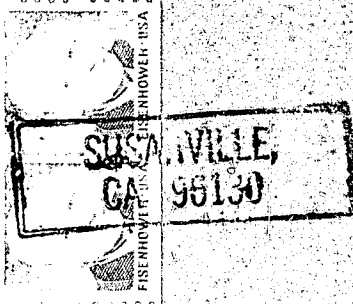
