AgEcon Search is a free web library that collects, indexes, and archives full text copies of scholarly research in the broadly defined field of agricultural economics including sub disciplines such as **agribusiness, food supply, natural resource economics, consumption, policy issues, agricultural trade, and economic development.**

AgEcon Search will serve as the permanent archive for the literature. Authors and organizations are encouraged to use this electronic library as the storehouse for their scholarly works.

WHAT IS INCLUDED
