Gentlemen:

In compliance with Section 65.5 of the Agricultural Code, I am submitting the 1963 Annual Crop and Livestock Report.

The production of Cattle and Calves continues to lead the county in agricultural value. Due to the increased rainfall and exceptionally cool spring and summer, pasture and range land were in much better condition than in years past. However, any increase in income from production of cattle and calves was off-set by a 3 to 4 cent reduction in price per pound received by the producer.

A noticeable reduction in Broilers, Fryers and Egg production is reported for 1963. This reduction can be contributed to; (1) lower prices received for eggs in the latter part of 1962; (2) poultry disease; (3) increased cost of production.

In 1963 Nevada County produced one of the largest crops of apples that has been recorded for a number of years. In addition to an exceptionally heavy yield, the quality was better than average.

Values per unit quoted in this report are before deductions for packing, freight and commission fees are made. Total value represents Gross Value only.

I wish to express my appreciation to ranchers, growers and to every one who cooperated in giving their information to make this report as accurate as possible.



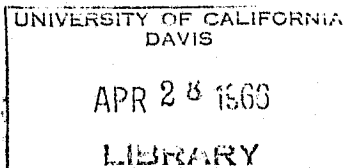

BEEF PRODUCTION IN NEVADA COUNTY

For the past several years beef production has been Nevada County's number one agricultural industry. By production we mean produced and sold from Nevada County and does not include livestock inventories or summer pastured stock from other counties.

Although no records are available previous to 1958, the production of Bartlett pears in some years probably was equal to or exceeded beef production in total value. But pear decline and fireblight gradually reduced pear production to an insignificant figure in this county.

During 1965 there were 118 farms in Nevada County raising beef cattle. This figure does not include family type operations, 4-H or FFA members. The average size of beef herds (cows, calves and bulls) in Nevada County is 68 animals.

The number of registered cows and calves reported as of January 1, 1966 are 679 head. The number of registered bulls reported are 119.



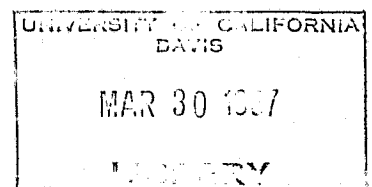

HISTORY OF FRUIT PRODUCTION IN NEVADA COUNTY

Nevada County fruit growing goes back to the early Gold Rush days. Miners brought their apples, pears and peaches and planted them here in the hills. They did surprisingly well. In fact, some of the fruit trees of the early Gold Rush days are still alive and bearing fruit.

Nevada County's fruit display at the Panama-Pacific International Exposition in San Francisco, 1915, won many gold medals. The display contained fifty-four (54) varieties of pears alone.

After World War I, Nevada County fruit was shipped to eastern markets by rail. Fruit was sold in New York City, Boston, Philadelphia, Montreal and other cities.

The pear industry in Nevada County survived the depression years and continued up to about 1958 when pear decline and fire blight brought an end to the pear industry here.

Apple trees are less susceptible to disease and frost damage which brought down the bartlett pear industry. A new type of fruit industry was launched in apples along with some hardier varieties of peaches and plums.

Fruit marketing started by hand packing under the shade of trees, progressed to automated packing sheds, and now as a result of marketing conditions, is back to the "shade tree" or "grower packer" operation again.
